Dear Sirs:

Dr. Carr, the president of the Murray State Normal School, is in the office and also Dr. Button, the president of the new Normal School at Morehead, Kentucky.

Dr. Carr says his trustees are going to meet on May 6, at Murray and that if your representative is present at that meeting, he feels confident that the regents will employ your firm to prepare the plan for the grounds of the school at Murray at not to exceed \$1,000.00 for your compensation.

Dr. Button says that his Board of Regents has already considered this question and has practically determined to employ your firm for the school at Morehead. He says also that if your representative comes to Murray on May 6 and will notify him, he will call a meeting of the Morehead Board of Regents, to be held at Morehead a day or two after your man is at Murray. If your representative will attend this meeting at Morehead, he feels confident that the employment for the Morehead school can be closed at that time.

Please communicate directly with Dr. John W. Carr, Murray State Normal School, Murray, Kentucky, advising him whether or not your representative will be in Murray on May 6.

Also communicate directly with Dr. F. C. Button, of Morehead, Kentucky, and arrange with him a date for the meet-

ing at Morehead, if you intend to have your man there.

The most convenient train for Murray leaves Louisville over the Illinois Central at 10 p. m. You have to get off at Paducah and take a train from there to Murray, leaving at 7:20 a. m., and reaching Murray at 8:38. You can leave Murray that night and get to Louisville the next morning. If the train is on time, you can leave Louisville by the C. & O. at 8:30 a. m., and reach Morehead without change about 1:35 p. m. The meeting of the Morehead regents can be had in the afternoon after this train arrives.
