Biographical / Historical Information: Reuel Buchanan, born May 26 1920, was a tourism and recreation instructor at Morehead State University. He was an important figure in the development of tourism and recreation in eastern Kentucky from the 1960s to the 1980s. Buchanan served as a member on the board of directors on both the Kentucky Festival Association, in which he also served as treasurer, and the Kentucky Highlands Association. He was also the Executive Director of the Morehead Recreation, Tourism and Convention Commission. He died on May 10, 1997.

Scope and Content: Collection consists of brochures, travel guides, historical booklets and newspaper clippings concerning tourism and recreation in the State of Kentucky. The bulk of the material focuses on the eastern region of the State. The collection features a series of photographic prints, slides and negatives of Kentucky recreation areas, historical sites and scenic areas across the State. Included are letters and memorandums between Buchanan, his colleagues and board members of various tourism and recreational organizations in Kentucky and surrounding states.
