Dear Sir:

From your letter of November 10th as well as from a letter of November 11th received from Joseph and Joseph, we understand that the new building is already under construction. Modifications in its location are, therefore, out of the question, and we will adjust our general layout plan to the building location you have adopted. We cannot help feeling that the relation between this accepted location and the rest of the general layout is not as good as it might be. Nevertheless we will endeavor to work out the adjustment in the best manner possible.

When we sent you our preliminary study on the 18th of September last we asked that it be submitted to your Board of Regents and that you write us any criticisms or suggestions for modification which you wished to make. As yet we have heard nothing from you as to whether the layout as proposed is satisfactory to you and your Board of Regents or not. As we wrote you recently, we are anxious to finish up this plan, but we hesitate to go ahead until we learn definitely from you whether or not the scheme is satisfactory. Please write us definitely and fully about this matter at your early convenience.

Would you also be good enough to ask Joseph and Joseph to send us the architectural elevations of the new building and the floor grades which have been established. We need this information in order to be sure that our general plan will fit the new building.
