The minutes of the last two meetings were read and approved.

Mrs. S. M. Bradley presented list of silverware, linen, etc. needed for entertainments in President's new home, and on motion, duly carried, Mrs. Bradley and Mrs. J. H. Payne were appointed a committee to purchase same. Said list is as follows:
