Contract No. 2 On motion of Dr. Rose, seconded by Judge Caudill and all members of the Board voting aye, on roll call, bid of J. D. Jennings on contract No. 2 of \$22,950.00 was accepted.

Contract No. 3. On motion of Dr. Taylor, seconded by Dr. Rose and all members of the Board voting aye, on roll call, bid of the Continental Chimney Company of \$3,230.00 was accepted.

Contract No. 4 On motion of Dr. Taylor, seconded by Dr. Rose and all members of the Board voting aye, on roll call, bid of Meyer Plumbing & Heating Company of \$29,988.00 with addition for extra vacuum pump \$875.00 and addition for covering return main in tunnel \$825.00, total \$31,688.00 was accepted.

Contract No. 5 On motion of Judge Caudill, seconded by Dr. Taylor and all members voting aye on roll call, bid of Henry Vogt Machine Company of \$45,222.00 and items Nos. 3, 5, & 7 not to exceed \$2468.00, total \$47,690.00 was accepted.

Contract No. 6 On motion of Dr. Richmond, seconded by Dr. Taylor and all members of the Board voting aye, on roll call, bid of Clark, Stewart & Wood was accepted as follows:

Owner reserves the option to accept bid on new water main to reservoir on hill at \$5,175.00. The Vogt Aeromix was recommended as it eliminates the baffles in contract #1, amounting to \$295.00 with the guarantee from Vogt Mfg. Co. that if baffles are required to produce the required standard of mix, they will be furnished and placed at the expense of the Vogt Mfg. Company. Wallace & Tiernan Chemical Feeder was recommended as Wallace & Tiernan equipment is now installed on the grounds and it is the desire, as far as possible, to standardize on equipment. This same item will be carried out with reference to pumps.

Contract No. 7 On motion of Secretary Senff, seconded by Dr. Rose and all members voting aye, on roll call, bid of the Marine Electric Company of \$9252.00 was accepted.

Contract No. 8 On motion of Dr. Richmond, seconded by Dr. Rose and all members of the Board voting aye, on roll call, bid of the General Electric Company of \$23,248.00 was accepted. It was recommended that a \$548 preference be given the General Electric Company due to the savings which will accrue on the steam rates quoted in bids and in order to standardize equipment, as far as possible, on the grounds.

Contract No. 9 On motion of Judge Caudill, seconded by Secretary Senff and all members voting aye, on roll call, bid of Columbus Conveyor Company of \$14,393.50 was accepted.

Contract No. 10 On motion of Dr. Richmond, seconded by Dr. Taylor and all members of the Board voting aye, contract No. 10 was offered J. C. Miller and upon his refusal, is awarded the Codell Construction Company at the sum of \$11,907.00.




Be it resolved by the Board of Regents of the Morehead State Teachers College:
