Minutes Read and Approved: On motion duly made and seconded, all voting Aye, the minutes of the meeting of the Board of Regents held January 30, 1941, were ordered approved as read.

Bill of Judge E. C. O'Rear: The bill of Judge E. C. O'Rear for an additional fee for representing the College in matters with respect to the affairs of Samuel M. Bradley, Treasurer, referred to in the Minutes of the Meeting of the Board held January 30, 1941, was further discussed by the Board. Messrs. Brooker and Shannon, appointed as a committee to interview Judge E. C. O'Rear, made their report. On motion of Mr. Ramey, seconded by Mrs. Young, and unanimusly carried, it was ordered:

"That further consideration of the bill of Judge E. C. O'Rear be deferred until the next meeting of the Board, and that President Vaughan and D. H. Putnam, Secretary, prepare a statement covering the history of this matter and present same at the next meeting of the Board."

"Leave of Absence granted Dr. J. G. Black: President Vaughan reported that Dr. J. G. Black, dead of the Department of Mathematics and Physics, had been requested by the authorities of the U. S. Government to engage in some studies on Defense Work to be done at the University of Michigan during the summer of 1941; that Dr. Black had requested that he be granted leave of absence for the summer of 1941 to engage in this work. President Vaughan recommended that this be granted.

On motion of Mr. Shannon, seconded by Mr. Ramey, all voting aye, it was ordered that leave of absence be granted to Dr. J. G. Black for the summer of 1941, without salary during the period of his absence.

Leaves of Absence - First Summer Term: On motion of Mr. Ramey, seconded by Mrs. Young, all voting aye, the following leaves of absence were granted for the first Summer Term of 1941:

Half salary to be paid to the above for the second Summer Term.

(b) Mr. Ross C. Anderson, Instructor, Dept. of Commerce Miss Helen Board, Instructor Training School
