

FRANKFORT, Jan. 4.—SENATE.—A resolution was passed that a committee of eight—three from the Senate and five from the House—be appointed to investigate the charges made in the Rowan County troubles; to be given full power to send for persons and papers. The appointments of about one hundred notaries were confirmed. The Committee on Judiciary was requested to report as soon as practicable, whether or not the present General Assembly can under the constitution repeal the act creating and organizing the county of Rowan.
