

July 6, 1944

A meeting of the Board of Regents of Morehead State Teachers College was held at the office of the president on Thursday, July 6, 1944, at 2:00 P. M., CWT.

The meeting was held pursuant to call by John Fred Williams, Chairman of the Board. The following Regents were present:

In the absence of Chairman Williams, the meeting was presided over by Mrs. Allie W. Young, Vice Chairman of the Board.

Minutes Read and Approved: On motion duly made and seconded, all voting Aye, the minutes of the last previous meeting of the Board held May 11, 1944, were read and approved.

Proposal for Naval R. O. T. C.: President Vaughan read a letter from the Navy Department and presented an application with respect to the establishment, after the war, of a Naval R. O. T. C. union at the college and recommended that the application be filed by the College.

On motion of Mr. LaViers, seconded by Mr. Putnam, all voting Aye, it was

"Resolved that the recommendation made by President Vaughan looking toward the establishment of a Naval R. O. T. C. unit at the College be approved, and that the application to the U. S. Navy, presented to the Board by President Vaughan, be made by the College."

Contract with Kentucky Utilities Company for Power: A report was made by Mr. LaViers of his discussions with the officials of the Kentucky Utilities Company regarding the proposed contract between Kentucky Utilities Company and the College whereby Kentucky Utilities Company would furnish power to the College for certain specified periods and whereby the College Power Plant would be held available as a stand-by unit for furnishing power to the Kentucky Utilities Company in the event of an emergency. As further discussions and decisions were necessary before this matter could be finally determined, no action was taken by the Board at this time and the Committee was continued.

Salaries Approved: On motion of Mr. LaViers, seconded by Mr. Shannon, all voting Aye on call of the roll, the salaries of the Faculty and staff of the College to be effective September 1, 1944, as submitted and recommended by President Vaughan, in list of date




