The Board of Regents of Morehead State College met at the residence of President Wm. Jesse Baird on May 31, 1950.

In the absence of the chairman, the meeting was called to order by the vice chairman, Mr. E. R. Price. The reading of the minutes of the meeting of April 11, 1950 was postponed.

President Baird presented a list of the candidates for graduation recommended by the faculty, for approval. On motion of Mr. Ball, seconded by Mr. Eblen and unanimously carried, the list of candidates was approved for graduation and the list is hereto appended and made a part of these minutes.

It was recommended by President Baird that Robert Laughlin, instructor in Physical Education, be given a sabbatical leave of absence for the school year at half salary and that Linus A. Fair, associate professor of Mathematics be given a sabbatical leave for the summer session of 1950 at full salary. Mr. Ball moved that this recommendation be approved and the vote was Mr. Price, aye, Mr. Ball, aye, Mr. Eblen, aye, and Mr. Norris, aye.
