One of Dr. Morgan's first orders of business is to begin crafting a new strategic plan for MSU. Leaders from Faculty Senate, Staff Congress, SGA as well as our Faculty and Staff Regents have worked together with Dr. Morgan to create a process through which all of us can have significant input in this process.

We have outlined four ad hoc committees that will be comprised of various faculty, staff and students. These committees will work together to draft various aspects of the new strategic plan. As MSU's Staff Congress, our job is to assist in populating the staff who will serve on these committees.

But we want everyone's input! We are asking all staff to nominate colleagues they believe are the most appropriate and qualified individuals to serve. The committees are:

**Student Success** (Recruitment, Retention, Progression, Graduation, Job Placement, State Metrics, Diversity)

**Outcomes-Performance Based Funding** (Model planning for MSU, Facilities master planning refresh, Fiscal Planning)

**Academic Excellence** (Academic enhancement, QEP, Experiential Education, Program Accreditation, Efficiency, Value, Branding, University Accreditation (SACSCOC), Diversity)

**Rankings, Reputation, and Regional Responsiveness** (MSU Rankings, Branding/Marketing, Regional Campuses, Alumni Development, etc.)

Please think about the staff you feel would be the most appropriate people to serve on each committee. You may nominate as many people as you would like. You may also nominate yourself.

Once Staff Congress has all the nominations, we will work with Dr. Morgan and the other constituent group leaders to finalize each committee.
