Page 7 change general electives from 3-18 to "18 semester hours."

Page 7 under Admission Requirements #2. Remove student must have a 3.0 GPA on all graduate course work. Remove #3 regarding GRE score. #5 change the wording to "Demonstrated competency of computer fluency." Page 8 under General Electives. Change wording to "Courses 600 or higher with recommendation of......"

Type IV: Ed.D Educational Leadership

Dr. David Barnett, Dr. Christopher Miller and Dr. Debbie Abell were in attendance to answer questions regarding the proposals. A motion was made by S. Wright to approve the proposal with revisions. The motion was seconded by G. Remillard. All members approved. The revisions are as follows:

Page 1 under Admission Requirements remove graduate office and change to "Enrollment Services."

Page 2 under Admission Requirements add "Documentation of previous statistical methodology, research related coursework or evidence of use and application of data-informed decision making to determine possible need for statistical methodology coursework."

Add wording regarding the writing sample to "or on demand writing sample."

Add "Official" in front of transcripts

Change appropriate TOEFL to University minimum TOEFL

Under Requirements for the Degree #1. Change wording to "Meet all program requirements."

#5 add cumulative in front of GPA

Add a #9 to reflect that "students are encouraged to complete the program within the cohort time limit. The program must be completed within 10 years."

Add a #10 to list the number of hours that will be permitted to be transferred.

Page 3 under Emphasis Areas. Change the wording to "Minimum of 12 hours." Change the Practicum from 3-6 hours to "Minimum of 3 hours."

A Type I proposal will need to be submitted to change the pre-requisite for EDIL 631B.
