### VIII. JOHN E. ALLEN BASEBALL FIELD

John "Sonny" Allen was an all-state basketball player at University Breckinridge School where he graduated in 1946. He played basketball at Morehead State University, scoring 1,923 points in four years. He was named to the All-Kentucky Intercollegiate Athletic Conference team

twice, the All-Ohio Valley Conference team twice, and was named an All-American in 1950. John coached basketball and baseball at University Breckinridge School from 1954 to 1963, winning 225 games and losing only 25 in baseball and in 1963 took the basketball team to the State tournament. He has been baseball coach at the University for 12 years, during which time his teams have won 177 games while losing 100, and also served as golf coach for a four-year period (1964-67). His baseball teams won the OVC championship in 1957, 1969, and 1973. Mr. Allen was named OVC "Coach of the Year" in baseball in 1957 and again in 1969 and will most likely receive the same honor this season.

### Interrelating of Library and Basic Education Services for Disadvantaged Adults



### A Resolution of the

# Morehead State University Board of Regents Relative to the Expansion of The Lee Cemetery

WHEREAS, there exists in the City of Morehead and Rowan County, The Lee Cemetery Company, Inc., a Kentucky Corporation. The Lee Cemetery Company, Inc., has duly requested that the Board of Regents consider a request to provide, by deed, additional lands for expansion of The Lee Cemetery. This Board takes notice that The Lee Cemetery Company, Inc., does not have adequate space for continued expansion. The Board further takes notice that on December 20, 1971 Morehead State University purchased lands surrounding The Lee Cemetery on the North and East sides that are duly recorded in Deed Book 95, page 56 of the Rowan County records.

WHEREAS, as a result of the topography of the lands adjacent to The Lee Cemetery, said lands are not usable to the University.

WHEREAS, in an effort to alleviate the land shortage existing with The Lee Cemetery Company, the Board, on May 13, 1972, authorized the President of Morehead State University to sign a deed for 200 feet more or less, providing expansion of burial lots North of the existing Lee Cemetery. The motion made by Mr. Cassity, seconded by Mr. McDowell carried unanimously.

WHEREAS, the President responsive to the intentions of the Board has caused to be prepared this resolution; along with a deed of conveyance. The properties to be conveyed are specifically described as follows:

BEGINNING at an iron pin, at the southwest corner of Lee Cemetery 1st Addition and property line of Parnell Martindale, thence with Martindale property N. 38<sup>0</sup>00' West 222.0 feet to a pine stump in line of Grantor; thence a straight line with property of Grantor, N.52<sup>0</sup>30'

East 534.83 feet to an iron pin, along side of drain; thence with drain S 28° 02' East 245.09 feet to an iron pin, line of Lee Cemetery 1st Addition; thence with line of Lee Cemetery 1st Addition, S. 52° 30' West 474 feet to iron pin, the place of beginning, containing 2.9 acres, more or less.

This being a part of the same property conveyed to the Commonwealth of Kentucky, for the use and benefit of Morehead State University, by Mrs. Corrine H. Duggan, Executrix under the Will of Nannie Dell Pennington Holbrook, dated December 20, 1971, recorded in Deed Book 95, page 56, Rowan County records for deeds.

WHEREAS, there exists the "Morehead Alumni Foundation, Inc." a non-profit, non-stock corporation organized and established under the provisions of the Kentucky Revised Statutes, and among the powers enumerated in its articles of incorporation is, authorized to ".....acquire, hold, lease, rent and mortgage, exchange or otherwise convey or deal in both real and personal property.....," and

WHEREAS, the Foundation has evidenced its interest in acquiring the above defined property for the purpose of conveyance to The Lee Cemetery Company, Inc., for the sum of \$1.00.

NOW, THEREFORE, Be it Resolved by the Board of Regents of the Morehead State University as follows:

- (1) That this Board is of the opinion and so finds and declares that the said property is surplus to the future expansion needs of Morehead State University.
- (2) The President of Morehead State University is hereby authorized and directed to communicate this Board's instructions as set forth in this Resolution by sending an exact copy hereof, signed by the Chairman, and attested by the Secretary, to the Commissioner of the Executive Department for Finance and Administration of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.
- (3) That the Board recommend to the Commissioner of the Executive Department for Finance and

Administration that said property be conveyed to the Morehead Alumni Foundation for a monetary consideration of \$1.00.

(4) That the President is hereby authorized, empowered and directed to do and perform in the name of the Board all acts necessary and proper to carry out in a lawful manner the Board's intentions as expressed herein:

For the past several months William C. Martin, architect, Lexington, Kentucky, has been investigating the failure of the thin stone veneer which was applied to the Doran Student House. Based on his final report, which was recently filed with this office, Joe Leary, our attorney, has filed a suit in Franklin Circuit Court against Frank Messer & Sons, Cincinnati, Ohio, and their surety.

Based on our attorney's recommendation, in which we fully concur, we request the issuance of a Commissioner of Finance Order authorizing Final Plans and Advertisement, based on an estimated construction cost of \$485,000, and a total project scope of \$601,000. An allotment of \$25,000 should be made to the 701 minor object code of the appropriate account number to cover the cost of the investigative report, design fee, duplication costs and estimated cost of expert testimony. \$8,600 should be allotted to the 718 minor object code to cover the estimated cost for legal fees.

I have spent much time, thought and research in the preparation of the Complaint, copy of which I am handing to you with this letter.

I see no escape from the following conclusions:

- (1) The exterior of the structure simply must be replaced. There is nothing to be gained by belaboring the obvious. The "back-up" walls and columns must be made plumb and adequate ventilation and drainage between the two must be provided.
- (2) The statute requires an undertaking of this magnitude to be bid competitively. No intelligent bid can be submitted by a reputable contractor until he has such plans and specifications as will permit him to bid and go forward with the work in the event he is successful.

I recommend, therefore, that such plans as are necessary to make this building conform to the original plans and specifications be prepared by an architect selected by the Department.

(3) I am neither unaware nor insensitive to the financial limitations which surround the completion of this structure. I am told that bond funds are substantially exhausted and I am not aware of a specific appropriation made for

this purpose by the General Assembly.

The Complaint undertakes to obtain an order of Court which will require Messer and its bondsman (one or both) to meet the progress payments of any contractor who may bid successfully on the project.

- (4) Heretofore, I have written to you suggesting that immediate steps be taken to protect the members of the public who use the area around the Doran building. It is a fair certainty that unless protective measures are taken some one (probably one or more students) will be injured and a "sticky wicket" will be further and tragically complicated by personal injury to some student or passerby.
- (5) Declaratory Judgment actions are more speedily determined than any which may be brought. I wish I could assure you that a matter of weeks only would pass until a conclusion can be reached in the courts, but I cannot. It will simply take such time as it takes, but there is no other recourse of which I have knowledge.

It goes without saying that if an opportunity is presented during the course of these proceedings whereby they may be concluded more speedily by compromise, arbitration or otherwise, I will advise you forthwith.

I cannot recall a pleading more difficult to draft than the Complaint which I have just handed to you. I have undertaken to prepare it with such skill as I possess and shall present it in the same fashion. Obviously, I will keep you advised.

I am handing you a copy of this letter for the Commissioner of Finance in the thought that he might find my observations of some passing interest.
