

On the Ragged Edge of War.

OWINGSVILLE, KY., June 13.—For several nights past two very suspicious-looking characters have been seen skulking around the town of Farmers, Rowan county, which place is the home of Marion Tolliver, Dr. June Wilson and others of the Tolliver factions in the recent Rowan county war. These men, Tolliver and Wilson, having reason to believe that the unknown men were friends of the Martin gang and boded them no good, armed themselves last night and went in search of those they supposed to be their enemies; they found them but could not get close enough to recognize or shoot them, and as they precipitately fled Dr. Wilson accidentally discharged his gun, a Spencer rifle, the ball taking effect in his right foot, making a painful wound. The people are greatly excited, and the greatest fears are entertained that the war it about to be reopened. The Tolliver faction in and around Farmers are all under arms for any emergency.
