ADAMS, JOHN

50 MINUTES - COLOR - TRACES EVOLUTION OF OUR HERITAGE OF JUSTICE, LAW, FREEDOM.

ADAM, JOHN QUINCY

50 MINUTES - B/W - A FUTURE PRESIDENT RISKS HIS POLITICAL CAREER TO SUPPORT PRINCIPLES OF THE FIRST 10 AMENDMENTS.

ALCOTT, LOUISA MAY

18 MINUTES - B/W - EVENTS FROM THE LIFE OF MISS ALCOTT REVEAL HER OUTSTANDING CHARACTER TRAITS - DEVOTION TO HER FAMILY, SENSE OF HUMOR AND INDUSTRIOUSNESS. SHOWS THAT LITTLE WOMEN, LITTLE MEN, JO'S BOYS WERE BASED LARGELY ON HER OWN EXPERIENCES.

AUDUBON, JOHN JAMES

4 MINUTES - COLOR - IN KENTUCKY, MISSISSIPPI AND THROUGHOUT THE UNITED STATES, AUDUBON PAINTED THE BIRDS HE LOVED. THIS FILM REVEALS THE BIRDS THEMSELVES, GAY AND BRILLIANT, PERCHED ON NESTS OF MUD AND TWIGS; ON LEAFY BOUGHS; FRESH AND INNOCENT.

BUCK, PEARL S.

30 MINUTES - B/W - MISS BUCK DESCRIBES HAPPY CHILDHOOD DAYS IN CHINA, POINTS OUT DIFFERENCES BETWEEN WESTERN AND ORIENTAL APPROACHES TO LIVING, DISCUSSES CHANGES THAT HAVE TAKEN PLACE UNDER COMMUNISM IN CHINA AND CONSIDERS WAYS IN WHICH AMERICA MAY RECOVER GOOD WILL LOST IN ASIA RECENTLY.

CLEVELAND, PRESIDENT GROVER

50 MINUTES - B/W - SURVEYS THE NEW FORCES AFFECTING AMERICA FOLLOWING THE CIVIL WAR. SHOWS HOW PRESIDENT CLEVELAND FOUGHT FOR A LOWER TARIFF DESPITE ADVICE TO THE CONTRARY FROM HIS ADVISORS. HE WAS DEFEATED IN THE ELECTION WHICH FOLLOWED.

BIOGRAPHY (CONT'D)

COOPER, JAMES FINIMORE

18 MINUTES - B/W - DRAMATIZES THE LIFE OF THE FIRST GREAT AMERICAN WRITER TO BASE HIS NOVELS ON THE AMERICAN FRONTIER SCENE. AFTER SEVERAL ADVENTUROUS YEARS IN THE NAVY, COOPER SETTLED DOWN TO A QUIET LIFE AS A GENTLEMAN FARMER, WROTE NOVELS BASED ON HIS YOUTHFUL VENTURES.

ELY, RICHARD T.

50 MINUTES - B/W - THE FREEDOM TO SEARCH FOR THE TRUTH. SOCIAL REFORM IN 19TH CENTURY AMERICA, THE DANGER OF "DESTROYING LIBERTY IN THE PROCESS OF DEFENDING IT." A COLLEGE PROFESSOR DEMANDS THAT HIS STUDENTS EXAMINE IDEAS, EVALUATE INFORMATION AND MAKE JUDGMENTS INDEPENDENT OF TRADITION.

FROST, ROBERT

30 MINUTES - B/W - AT HIS FARM HOME IN VERMONT, FRST RECALLS THE WIDE RANGE OF PERSONAL EXPERIENCES - AS A MILL WORKER, COUNTRY SCHOOL TEACHER, COBBLER, SMALL-TOWN EDITOR, AND FARMER - THAT FURNISHED THE BACKGROUND FOR HIS ACHIEVEMENTS IN POETRY. HE READS TWO POEMS.

HAMILTON, EDITH

30 MINUTES - COLOR - A TEACHER, WRITER, AND INTERNATIONAL AUTHORITY OF ANCIENT GREEK AND ROMAN CULTURES TALKS IN HER MAINE HOME. SHE SPEAKS OF WAYS IN WHICH THE GREEK CIVILIZATION WAS UNIQUE IN HISTORY, OF THE FUNDAMENTALS OF GREEK PHILOSOPHY, AND OF REASONS FOR GREECE'S FALL.

HOLMES, OLIVER

18 MINUTES - B/W - DRAMATIZES EPISODES FROM HOLMES' LIFE. POINTS OUT HIS CONTRIBUTIONS AS A MAN OF MEDICINE, OF LETTERS, AND AS A LECTURER, HIGHLIGHTING EVENTS INCIDENTAL TO WRITING OLD IRONSIDES, AUTOCRAT OF THE BREAKFAST TABLE AND OTHER WORKS.

BIOGRAPHY (CONT'D)

HOUSTON, GOVERNOR SAM

50 MINUTES - B/W - THE SANCTITY OF A CONTRACT, THE CONFLICT OVER FREEDOM VS. SLAVERY IN THE TERRITORIES. MOB PSYCHOLOGY, VIOLENCE AS A SOLUTION TO DISAGREEMENTS. THE PROUD TEXAN WHO SUFFERED POLITICAL MARTYRDOM BECAUSE "HE LOVED HIS COUNTRY, HE WAS A PATRIOT, HE WAS DEVOTED TO THE UNION."

HUTCHINSON, ANNE

50 MINUTES - B/W - ANNE HUTCHINSON STRUGGLES WITH THE RIGID PURITAN CHURCH HIERARCHY FOR PERSONAL RELIGIOUS FREEDOM. SHE LOSES IN COURT TO GOVERNOR WINTHROP AND IS BANNED FROM MASSACHUSETTS. WE SEE WHY FREEDOM OF RELIGION IS A BASIC CONSTITUTIONAL RIGHT.

IRVING, WASHINGTON

18 MINUTES - B/W - BRINGS TO LIFE SIGNIFICANT EPISODES IN THE LIFE OF WASHINGTON IRVING. TRACES HIS EARLY LIFE IN NEW YORK, AS A LAWYER AND THEN AS A WRITER. DESCRIBES TRAVELS AND LIFE ABROAD, HIGHLIGHTING INCIDENTS ON WHICH HINGED THE WRITING OF HIS BEST KNOWN LITERARY WORKS.

JOHNSON, SENATOR ANDREW

50 MINUTES - B/W - THE PRESERVATION OF THE UNION VS. STATES RIGHTS; THE ECONOMIC PARADOXES FACED BY A BORDER STATE; THE DECLINE OF AGRARIAN AMERICA. SENATOR ANDREW JOHNSON,, THE ONLY U.S. SENATOR TO RETAIN HIS SEAT WHEN HIS STATE (TENNESSEE) HAD LEFT THE UNION.

JOURNALS OF LEWIS & CLARK

27 MINUTES - COLOR - FAITHFUL TO THE JOURNALS AND COVERING THE SAME TERRAIN TRAVELED BY LEWIS & CLARK, THIS CAPTURES THE WONDER OF THE VIRGIN WEST, RECOUNTS AN HEROIC CHAPTER IN THE DEVELOPMENT OF THE FRONTIER, SUGGESTS THE PROBLEMS OF CONSERVATION AND INDIAN SUBJUGATION.

JOURNEY TO YESTERDAY

10 MINUTES - B/W - PRESENTS THE DISCOVERY OF THE CURE FOR YELLOW FEVER BY WILLIAM GORGAS AND ITS IMPORTANCE TO THE COMPLETION OF THE PANAMA CANAL.

JULIUS CAESAR

33 MINUTES - B/W - A CONDENSED VERSION OF SHAKESPEARE'S COMPLETE PLAY PORTRAYED BY A PROFESSIONAL CAST.

LINCOLN AS A PIONEER YOUTH

27 MINUTES - B/W - FROM THE TEEN-AGE BOY AT A BACKWOODS "BLAB SCHOOL" TO THE TALL YOUNG MAN STARTING LIFE ON HIS OWN; FRIENDSHIPS AND HARDSHIPS IN RURAL AMERICA, THE KIND OF MAN ABE GREW TO BE.

LINCOLN: FRONTIER FAMILY

28 MINUTES - B/W - THE LIFE OF A PIONEER FAMILY IN THE EARLY 1800'S. THE FRONTIER CHILDHOOD OF THE NATION'S FUTURE PRESIDENT; THE ROLE OF YOUNG ABE'S MOTHER.

LINCOLN: THE END AND BEGINNING

27 MINUTES - B/W - FROM THE PRESIDENT AT THE WHITE HOUSE AT THE TIME OF LEE'S SURRENDER TO THE ASSASSINATION; THE FUNERAL TRAIN CROSSING THE COUNTRYSIDE, BACK TO THE CABIN IN WHICH TOM AND NANCY HANKS LINCOLN WELCOME A NEW SON.

LINCOLN: THE FUTURE PRESIDENT

33 MINUTES - B/W - THE FUTURE PRESIDENT. A YOUNG BACKWOODS LAWYER LOSES AND THEN REGAINS HIS FAITH IN HIMSELF. THE FUTURE PRESIDENT GAINS STRENGTH.

LINCOLN: THE YOUNG LAWYER

30 MINUTES - B/W - THE YOUNG LAWYER IN NEW SALEM. THE PLUNGE INTO THE POLITICAL ARENA; A YOUNG MAN'S AMBITION FOR PUBLIC OFFICE. THE ANN RUTLEDGE LEGEND; A FUTURE CLOUDED BY DOUBT.

BIOGRAPHY (CONT'D)

LONGFELLOW, HENRY WADSWORTH

17 MINUTES - B/W - EVENTS IN HIS LIFE WHICH REVEAL HIS DEDICATION TO CREATING A NATIVE AMERICAN POETRY AND TO ENCOURAGING A TASTE FOR THE POETRY OF OTHER COUNTRIES. INTERPOSES SELECTIONS FROM HIS POEMS AND DRAMATIZES INCIDENTS WHICH INSPIRED SUCH WORKS AS EVANGE - LINE.

MAGIC ALPHABET, THE

11 MINUTES - B/W - DR. CHRISTIAN ELJKMAN'S EXPERIEMENTS IN JAVA TO DISCOVER THE CAUSE OF BERIBERI. HIS ACCIDENTAL DISCOVERY OF VITAMIN B<sup>1</sup> FOLLOWED BY THE DISCOVERY OF OTHER VITAMINS AND THEIR IMPORTANCE TO HEALTH.

MARSHALL, CHIEF JUSTICE

50 MINUTES - B/W - IN THE TRIAL OF AARON BURR IN VIRGINIA IN 1807, WE LEARN HOW THE CONSTITUTION PROTECTS AMERICAN CITIZENS FROM ACCUSATIONS OF TREASON. MARSHALL EXPLAINS: "JEFFERSON IS NOT A KING....IN THE REPUBLIC THE PLOTTING OF TREASON DOES NOT CONSTITUTE THE ACT OF TREASON.

MASON, GEORGE

50 MINUTES - B/W - WE SEE THE VIRGINIA RATIFYING CONVENTION RESOLVE AT THE INSISTENCE OF GEORGE MASON OF VIRGINIA, THAT THE FIRST ORDER OF BUSINESS FOR THE NEW CONGRESS BE TO AMEND THE CONSTITUTION WITH A BILL OF RIGHTS.

ORDEAL OF WOODROW WILSON

26 MINUTES - B/W - EXAMINES REASONS WILSON TOOK THE NATION TO WAR, COMMENTS ON HIS ACTIVITIES AS A WARTIME PRESIDENT, THEN FOCUSES ON HIS VAIN STRUGGLE TO CREATE THE INTERNATIONAL MACHINERY FOR A LASTING PEACE. FEATURES NARRATION AND PERSONAL COMMENTARY BY HERBERT HOOVER.

13½ MINUTES - COLOR - PAINTINGS CREATED IN THE STYLE OF POE'S WRITINGS ARE SKILLFULLY PRESENTED TO BRING TO LIFE SCENES FROM HIS WORKS AGAINST A BACKGROUND OF POE'S LIFE. EXCERPTS FROM "TO HELEN," "THE FALL OF THE HOUSE OF USHER," "THE MURDERS IN THE RUE MORGUE," "THE RAVEN."

PORTRAIT OF A GENIUS

10 MINUTES - B/W - LEONARDO DA VINCI AS AN INVENTOR, DETERMINED TO FIND WAYS TO ACCOMPLISH WHAT OTHERS SAY CANNOT BE DONE. ILLUSTRATED WITH HIS DRAWINGS.

SANDBURG, CARL

30 MINUTES - B/W - THE FAMOUS AMERICAN POET, BIOGRAPHER OF LINCOLN AND PULITZER PRIZE WINNER, PLAYS HIS GUITAR AND SINGS FOLK SONGS IN A STYLE NO LESS FAMILIAR THAN HIS GIFT FOR POETRY. HE RECALLS ADVENTURES AS A NEWSPAPER REPORTER AND SPEAKS OF HIS LIFELONG DEDICATION TO LINCOLN'S LIFE.

SERVANT OF MANKIND

9 MINUTES - B/W - A BRIEF BIOGRAPHY OF THOMAS ALVA EDISON, SOME OF HIS AMAZING ACHIEVEMENTS AND THEIR EFFECTS UPON LIFE TODAY.

SHAKESPEARE: SOUL OF AN AGE

54 MINUTES - COLOR - MOVES FROM LANDMARK TO LANDMARK IN SHAKESPEARE'S LIFE, PICTURING AUTHENTIC MAPS, BUILDINGS, TOWNS, ESTATES AND CITIES. SIR MICHAEL REDGRAVE RECITES ILLUSTRATIVE PASSAGES FROM SPEECHES IN SHAKESPEARE'S CHRONICLES, COMEDIES AND TRAGEDIES - SOME FIFTEEN IN ALL.

SHAKESPEARE, WILLIAM

25 MINUTES - COLOR - RECREATES ELIZABETHAN SOCIETY AND THE LIFE OF WILLIAM SHAKESPEARE FROM EARLY BOYHOOD THROUGH THE YEARS SPENT AS PLAYWRIGHT AND ACTOR IN LONDON. DRAMATIZES SCENES FROM RICHARD III, HAMLET, JULIUS CAESAR, MACBETH, AS THEY WOULD HAVE BEEN PERFORMED AT THE GLOBE THEATRE.

SHAW, GEORGE BERNARD

26 MINUTES - B/W - ACTUAL FILM CLIPS SHOWS SOME OF GEORGE BERNARD SHAW'S MAJOR IDEAS; DESCRIBE HOW HIS WORK AND ART REFLECTED AND CHANGED SOCIETY; AND DEPICTS THE SURFACE "BUFFOON" PERSONALITY GBS PRESENTED TO THE WORLD.

STAIRWAY TO LIGHT

10 MINUTES - B/W - DR. PHILIPPE PINEL, OBSCURE FRENCH DOCTOR, UNSHACKLES HIS INSANE PATIENTS TO HELP FREE THEIR MINDS, THUS PIONEERING IN THEIR MODERN HUMANE TREATMENT. AN ACADEMY AWARD WINNER.

STORY OF ALFRED NOBEL, THE

11 MINUTES - B/W - THE EXPERIMENTS AND RESEARCH WHICH LED TO NOBEL'S INVENTION OF DYNAMITE. HIS DISMAY AT ITS DESTRUCTIVE USE IN WAR AND THE DECISION TO LEAVE HIS FORTUNE TO THE PROMOTION OF PEACE, ESTABLISHING THE NOBEL PRIZE AWARDS.

STORY OF DOCTOR CARVER, THE

10 MINUTES - B/W - PRESENTS THE AGRICULTURAL EXPERIEMENTS AND ACHIEVEMENTS OF DR. GEORGE WASHINGTON CARVER, THE SCIENTIST WHO WAS BORN A SLAVE.

TRAGEDY OF JOHN MILTON

27 MINUTES - B/W - AUGUST 13, 1660, THE BLIND POET IS DRIVEN INTO HIDING BY CHARLES II AND HIS WORK ORDERED DESTROYED.

TWAIN, MARK: BACKGROUND FOR  
HIS WORKS

13 MINUTES - COLOR - AUTHENTIC BACKGROUNDS, QUOTATIONS, AND REENACTMENTS ENRICH THE STUDY OF MARK TWAIN'S WORKS. HIS COLORFUL BOYHOOD ON THE MISSISSIPPI IS SHOWN TO BE A SOURCE OF HIS MAJOR WRITINGS; OTHER WORKS REFLECT HIS LIFE AS JOURNALIST, YARN SPINNER AND HUMORIST.

TWAIN, MARK: GIVES AN INTERVIEW

13 MINUTES - COLOR - MR. HAL FOLBROOK'S AMAZING PHYSICAL RESEMBLANCE TO MARK TWAIN, HIS SKILL IN REPRODUCING THE GREAT AUTHOR'S MANNERISM AND THE WITTY AND PUNGENT DIALOGUE EXCERPTED FROM TWAIN'S WRITINGS COMBINE TO MAKE THIS AN INTRIGUING AND MEMORABLE FILM.

BUSINESS EDUCATION

SECRETARY, THE: A NORMAL DAY

11 MINUTES - COLOR - FOLLOWING JOAN THROUGH A NORMAL DAY IN A MODERN OFFICE, WE LEARN ABOUT TYPICAL SECRETARIAL RESPONSIBILITIES SUCH AS MAKING APPOINTMENTS, GREETING VISITORS, PROCESSING INCOMING MAIL, SUPERVISING FILE CLERKS, ORGANIZING A BUSINESS TRIP, TAKING DICTATION AND TRANSCRIBING.

SECRETARY, THE: TAKING DICTATION

11 MINUTES - COLOR - A GOOD SECRETARY HAS PROPER MATERIALS ORGANIZED TO RESPOND QUICKLY TO THE BOSS' CALL. SHE KNOWS CORRECTLY HOW TO INDICATE SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONS, WHEN TO INTERRUPT AND WHEN NOT, HOW TO "KEY" DICTATION TO LETTERS BEING ANSWERED AND OTHER ROUTING PROCEDURES.

SECRETARY, THE: TRANSCRIBING

11 MINUTES - COLOR - FOLLOWING JOAN THROUGH A TYPICAL SERIES OF TRANSCRIBING ASSIGNMENTS WE LEARN ABOUT THE PLACING OF WORK MATERIALS TO AVOID WASTE MOTION; ESTABLISHING PRIORITIES TO THAT RUSH ITEMS GET OUT FIRST; AND TYPING TECHNIQUES FOR FASTER, NEATER

16 MINUTES - COLOR - A GROUP OF STUDENTS AND THEIR COUNSELOR EXAMINE SCHOLASTIC APTITUDE

11 MINUTES - B/W - COURAGEOUS DR. EPHRAIM MCDOWELL DEFIES PROFESSIONAL RIDICULE AND PUBLIC PROTEST TO PERFORM THE WORLD'S FIRST MAJOR OPERATION ON A HUMAN BEING. THUS BEGINNING MODERN SURGERY.

OPEN HEART OPERATION

27 MINUTES - B/W - A FILM RECORD OF AN OPEN HEART SURGICAL OPERATION TO REPAIR A HOLE IN THE WALL OF THE HEART OF A 5 YEAR OLD GIRL. AT THE UNIVERSITY OF MINNESOTA HOSPITAL.

OUT OF DARKNESS

55 MINUTES - B/W - AN AWARD-WINNING DOCUMENTARY REPORT ON ONE WOMAN'S STEP-BY-STEP RECOVERY FROM MENTAL ILLNESS. PRODUCED BY CBS PUBLIC AFFAIRS IN COOPERATION WITH THE AMERICAN PSYCHIATRIC ASS'N., AND THE NATIONAL ASSOCIATION FOR MENTAL HEALTH.

POSTURE IN MOTION

9 MINUTES - COLOR - CONFIDENCE, EFFICIENCY AND BEAUTY RELATE TO GOOD POSTURE. A DEMONSTRATION OF ACCEPTABLE AND UNACCEPTABLE PROCEDURES ARE CONTRASTED IN: (1) WALKING (2) STANDING (3) SITTING (4) WALKING UP AND DOWN STAIRS.

SNEEZES AND SNIFFLES

10 MINUTES - B/W - WHY COLDS START, HOW THEY SPREAD AND WHAT TO DO TO PREVENT THEM. THE FILM EFFECTIVELY PORTRAYS THE MOST COMMON WAYS IN WHICH THE BODY DEFENDS ITSELF AGAINST GERMS.

STRESS

11 MINUTES - B/W - DR. HANS SELYE OF THE UNIVERSITY OF MONTREAL DISCUSSES HIS REVOLUTIONARY THEORY OF STRESS. HE EXPLAINS THE NATURE OF "STRESS" AS A GENERAL ALARM REACTION THROUGH THE PITUITARY AND ADRENAL GLANDS SET OFF BY AN ATTACK SUCH AS DISEASE, INJURY, MENTAL STRAIN.

CHAUCER'S ENGLAND

30 MINUTES - COLOR - FOLLOWS CHAUCER'S PILGRIMS - THE KNIGHT, WIFE OF BATH, MILLER, PARDONER, AND OTHERS - ON THEIR WAY TO CANTERBURY, TELLING STORIES AS THEY RIDE, PRESENTS A DRAMATIZATION OF THE PARDONER'S TALE, AN IRONIC STORY OF THE FOLLY OF AVARICE, VERSE TRANSLATED BY THEODORE MORRISON.

COMPARATIVE READING

11 MINUTES - COLOR - BY COMPARING ARTICLES IN TWO ENCYCLOPEDIAS, JEFF GAINS AN UNDERSTANDING OF DIFFERING DEFINITIONS IN GEOGRAPHY. LINDA COMES TO KNOW MARK TWAIN THROUGH HIS WORKS ABOUT HIM. DON DEVELOPS INSIGHTS INTO PILGRIM LIFE THROUGH COMPARATIVE READING.

DAVID COPPERFIELD: THE BOY
