Biographical / Historical Information: The Quicksand Regular Baptist Church was establish in 1839 in Breathitt County, Kentucky, shortly after the county's formation. The church was organized and pastored by Daniel Duff, originally from North Carolina, until 1855. Church met the second Saturday of every month, services temporarily ceased during the Civil War. The church is believed to have closed its doors in 1898.

Scope and Content: Ledger consists of church meeting minutes from 1858 to 1898 and includes a membership list.
