At a Meeting of the Board of  
Trustees of the Christian Church  
at Monroeville Ky. Held at the Post  
Office in Monroeville Ky. Aug. 26<sup>th</sup> 1911

J. M. Carey upon Motion of Hiram Bradley  
was elected Chairman of said Board

At a special meeting of the Board of Trustees of the Morehead Christian Church duly called for that purpose, and held on the 26<sup>th</sup> day of August, 1911, at the Post Office in Morehead, Ky., at which were present the entire membership of said Board, to-wit: Hiram Bradley, J. The Board/was officially ~~advised~~ that the Church has by vote of the congregation advised the acceptance of said proposition.


Thereupon J. M. Carey moved that said offer be accepted. H.M. Logan seconded said motion. Same being put for a vote it carried unanimously.

Thereupon H. M. Logan moved that the Chairman of this Board be ordered and directed to make, sign execute and deliver to said F. C. Button a general warranty deed for for the following described property, to-wit:

And said chairman having produced to this Board his deed of this date made and executed in accordance with the above direction of this Board and in all respects ready for delivery, and same being submitted to the Board and its members for inspection, and having ~~read to the Board~~ <sup>read to the Board</sup> and been carefully ~~inspected~~ examined by the Board, same was approved, and delivery of same to F. C. Button was then and thereby made in the presence, and on behalf of, this Board acting for the Morehead Christian Church, the said F. C. Button then and there paying to this Board the sum of ~~\$300~~ THREE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$300.00) in lawful money of the United States of America in consideration thereof.
