At a regular meeting of the Ladies Aid Society of the Christian Church of Morehead, Kentucky, held on Wednesday, Sept., 11, 1912, on motion of Mrs. J. M. Carey, seconded by Mrs. W. P. Lawrence the following resolution was adopted:

WHEREAS, this Society has completed the payment of the entire sum of \$1000.00, the purchase price of the city lot deeded to it by S.M. Bradley, on May 25, 1910, and which is located in Morehead, Rowan County, Kentucky, and described herein below, and

WHEREAS, said property was purchased in the first place by this Society for the benefit of the Christian Church of Morehead, Kentucky, to enable said Christian Church of Morehead to erect thereon a church building which the said Christian Church of Morehead, Kentucky, now offers to do and is ready to begin,

THEREFORE, Resolved that this Society does hereby authorize its president Mrs. Hiram Bradley, to make, execute, sign, acknowledge and deliver for and on behalf of the Ladies Aid Society of the Christian Church of Morehead, Kentucky, its General Warranty Deed of Conveyance to the trustees of the Christian Church of Morehead, Kentucky, and their successors and assigns for and in consideration of the premises and \$1.00 cash in hand the following described property, to-wit; A certain lot of ground in the City of Morehead, Rowan County, Kentucky, conveyed to the Ladies Aid Society of the Christian Church of Morehead, Kentucky, by S.M. Bradley, by deed of Conveyance of the date of May 25, 1910, and which is recorded in Deed Book 15 page 617 of the Rowan County records and located on the corner of Main Street and Bishop Avenue and what is part of what was formerly the old Central Hotel lot and which is described as follows:

Beginning at the corner of Main-St., and Bishop-ave., and running thence with Bishop-ave., 138 feet to the corner of C.P. Terrill's lot at his fence; thence a little north of east with the line of Terrill to the corner of Hood, a distance of 76 feet; thence leaving the Terrill line and running with the Hood line a north of west direction a distance of 140 feet to the east line of Main Street; thence with the east line of Main Street, a distance of 60 feet to the beginning point.

An application for a loan of \$2,000⁰⁰ from the Church Extension fund was read and signed.

J. A. Robison, J. M. Riley and H. P. Blair were made a sub-committee to superintend the building of a new church house.

At a meeting of the Board of Officers of the Church of Christ held at the Church House in Shorehead, Ky. Feb. 9th, 1913 the following were present, Geo. H. Harley, Dr. A. L. Blair, W. P. Lawrence, Brian Bradley and Wm. Nickell, J. M. Harley.

Dr. Blair, G. H. Harley and Brian Bradley were appointed a committee to get a preacher for a protracted meeting.

Brother J. Wesley Hatcher was elected to serve as one of the Elders of the church.

Brian Bradley was elected Chairman of the Board of Officers.
