# STATE TO GET MONEY

## GOVERNMENT AID IN ESTABLISHING AGRICULTURAL EXTENSION WORK

\$100,000 in Amount Given by Lever Bill, Which Has Been Approved by Lower House of Congress.

Lexington, Ky.—Machinery was allocated \$100,000 by the U. S. Senate Committee on Agriculture, which favorably reported the Lever bill appropriating \$5,000,000 for agricultural extension departments in the various state agricultural schools. The house has already passed the measure.

Senator Smith, of South Carolina, wrote the report and secured Secretary's allotment on investigation made by Chairman Lever, of the House Committee on Agriculture. The report provides that the state shall receive \$100,000 from the federal government, which Kentucky college, the bill passed by the State University at Lexington.

The object of this appropriation, the largest that has ever been made for the purpose, is to establish agricultural extension departments under the direction of the land grant colleges of the several states to aid in carrying to the people useful and practical information on subjects connected with agriculture and home economics.

Not until the Lever bill is approved by the House of Representatives will definite plans be approved by the lower house of Congress. The bill passed, distributing \$100,000 to the agricultural schools the house committed itself to the measure, and the move of this character that has been before it in fifty years.

The purpose of the new measure is to help those states that are interested in helping themselves by extending to the people the benefits of agricultural science. Where a state has no such law, it is up to the state legislature to act on which to give the money. No provision is made for giving the amount allotted between more than one school.
