On a motion by J. E. Blair seconded by Arthur Blair was voted that the present body of men decide on a lot on which to erect the new Christian Church building in question. There being two lots to decide between the one now owned by the Christian Church and the one owned by Art Young adjoining the property of H. C. Lewis on Main Street. It was agreed upon that the new building to erected on the lot now owned by the Church upon which the old Christian Church building now sits, unless a satisfactory deal can be made with Art Young for the corner lot joining the present Church property.

On motion by W. S. Brown seconded by J. C. Burton and voted that Bro Clark be instructed to secure plans and submit to the building committee by the 17th of acceptance or rejection. The plans to be submitted are to be the same as drawn for Hazard Christian Church and if accepted by both churches then the blue prints to be drawn and laid out for the two churches in equal parts.
