# Spectacular One-Car Crash Kills Lonnie Davis Jr. Here Monday



**DEATH CAR**—This 1962 model convertible—or what remains of it—is the one in which Lonnie Davis Jr. was killed Monday about five miles west of Morehead. The car struck the side of a

railway overpass and Davis was thrown over the railing, landing about 75 feet below at the base of the structure.

A 30-year-old Morehead man was dead on arrival at Morehead's St. Claire Medical Center Monday following a spectacular one-car accident near Bluestone.

Lonnie Davis Jr., a father of four, apparently died when he was thrown from his 1962 model convertible after striking the side of an overpass on US 60 about five miles west of Morehead.

State police said witnesses told them the accident happened this way:

The Davis car, traveling at an apparent high rate of speed, passed a car just before entering the overpass. Suddenly it went out of control, striking the south side of the structure. The car then careened to the north side, where it flipped in mid-air, throwing Davis from it, and over the rail. He fell approximately 75 feet to the ground.

The car continued back across the road and again struck the south side of the overpass, and came to rest.

Trooper Robert Morguson investigated the mishap.

Funeral services for Davis will be held today (Thursday) at 1 p.m. in Morehead's First

Among the first generation of barbers in Merced were Jesse Johnson, also his wife was a barber and they both worked together in an "Old Barbers Shop" located in the Phoenix Hotel. After moving to Merced Mrs. Johnson stepped out with her own operation located in a restaurant on Carey Avenue. It was considered the best.

Arville Martin and his brother Chris operated Martin Barber located on W. Main Street at the corner of N. Blair Ave. That's where the author remembers getting his first hair cut. That was before the days of electric clippers and they used hand clippers they squeaked back and forth and made a clucking sound. Plus they would frequently pull hair out instead of cutting it. Sometimes getting your hair cut with hand clippers click-click clucky along was a painful experience. Arville was known to "tip the scale" on Saturday night, and would sometimes try to take the President of the United States. Jim Robinson went to work to stop that but he at least went straight to the top. The hair cut at Martin Barber shop cost 25¢ - but a quarter was hard to come by in the 1930's and most people had never seen hand clippers and someone in the family was proficient at cutting hair.
