
## Foreword

I am pleased to present this annual report of sponsored programs at Morehead State University for the 2007 – 2008 fiscal year. Compiled by Ms. Janet Graybell in the Office of Research and Sponsored Programs, this report provides both an overview as well as detailed information of the external funding received by MSU to support our many on- and off-campus programs.

As may be seen in this report, MSU faculty and staff received a record level of funding over the past fiscal year. Specifically, as result of their efforts, the university was **awarded over \$17 million** in new funding to support the instructional, research, and public service mission of the University. This new funding record represented a 10.8% increase over the previous fiscal year (see page II-1). Although there was only a slight increase in the number of proposals submitted (184 vs 182), there was over a 40% increase in the dollar value of proposals submitted (\$26.6 million vs \$18.6 million). Overall, 75% of the proposals submitted were ultimately funded. The Division/College displaying the greatest gain in funding over the previous fiscal year was the Institute for Regional Analysis and Public Policy (IRAPP) with a funding increase of over \$2.5 million dollars. Of this \$2.5 million increase for IRAPP, over \$1.6 million was the result of a new award from the U.S. Department of Education for the East Kentucky Regional GEAR-UP Project. The total award for this project over the next five years will be over \$10 million.

Consistent with previous years, over 80% of the funding was obtained either directly or indirectly from federal funding sources with the largest amount from the U.S. Department of Education (over \$9.5 million). Of the remaining dollars awarded, 16% was received from the State of Kentucky, with the remaining 4% coming from foundations and other private sources. As expected, most of the funding received will directly or indirectly benefit students. Indeed, funding for instruction, academic services, student services, and student financial aid accounted for almost 60% of total funding. Awards for public service projects and research (applied and basic) accounted for roughly 26% and 12%, respectively. Most federal research funding was received through the National Institutes of Health and the National Science Foundation (see page IV-1).

Over the past ten years, external support for our programs has increased almost 80%. This increase has greatly benefitted the university as well as the communities in our service region. It is important to recognize that these awards are solely due to the efforts of the dedicated faculty and staff listed in this report. We applaud their efforts and congratulate them for their success in securing the external resources necessary for MSU to provide the highest quality educational, research, and public service programs for our constituents.



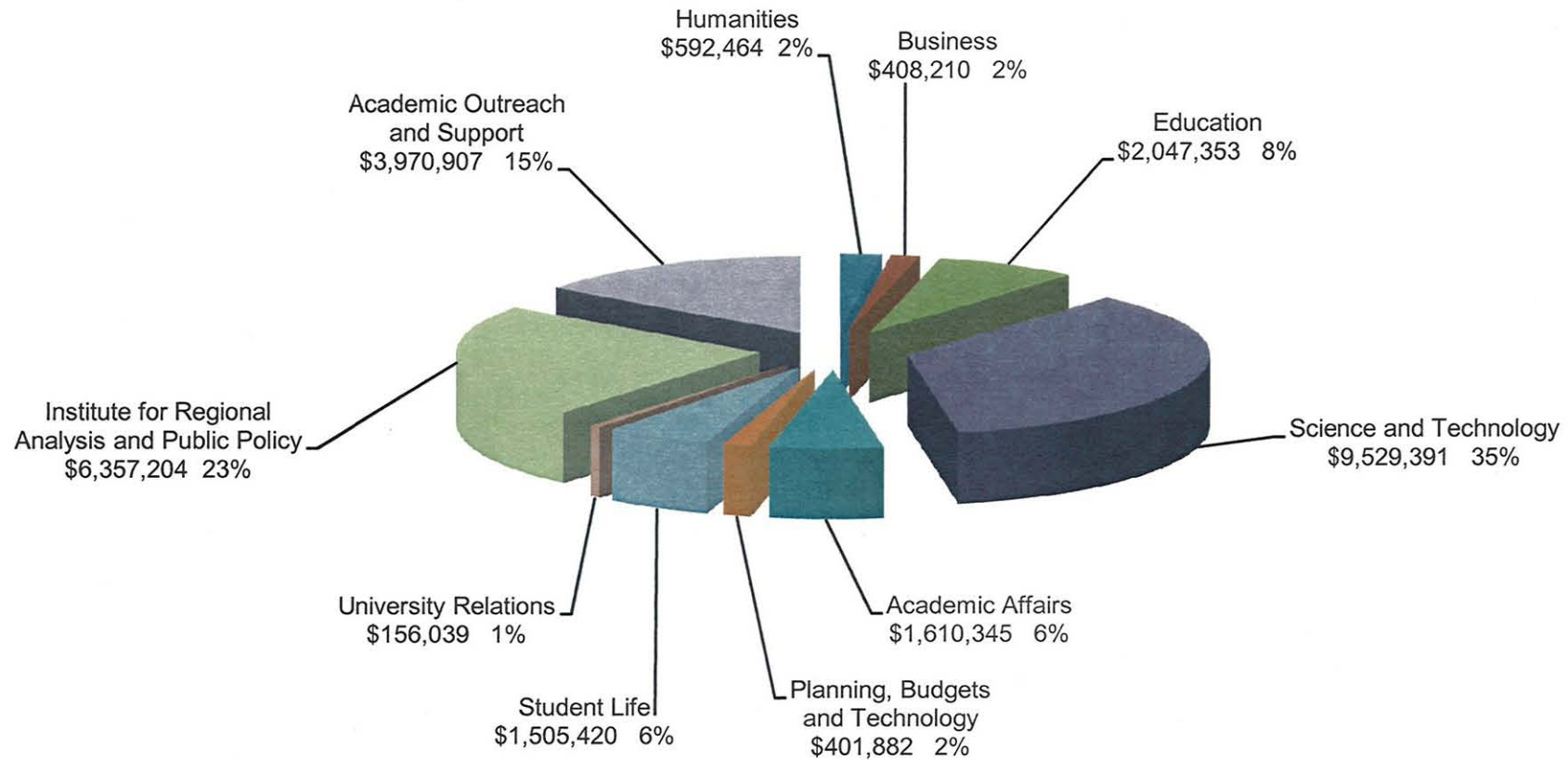

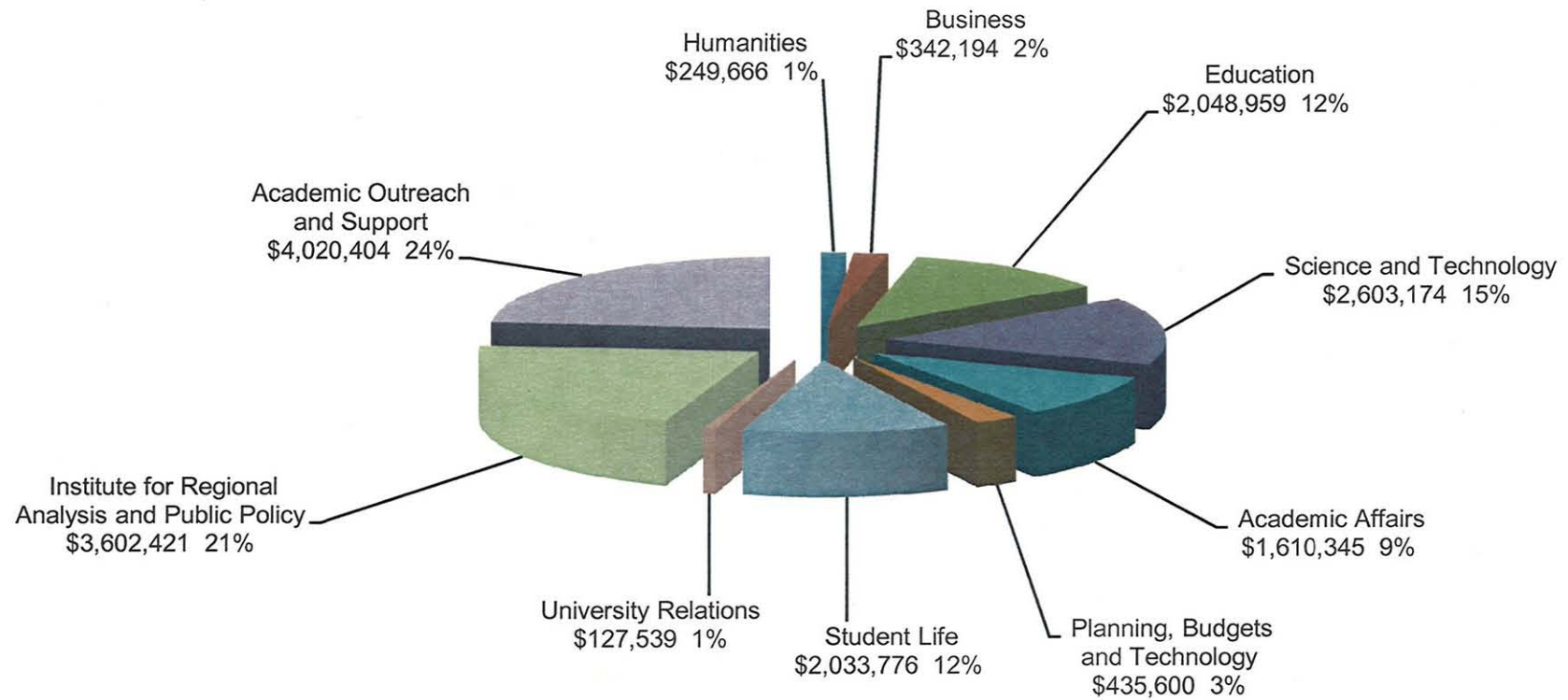

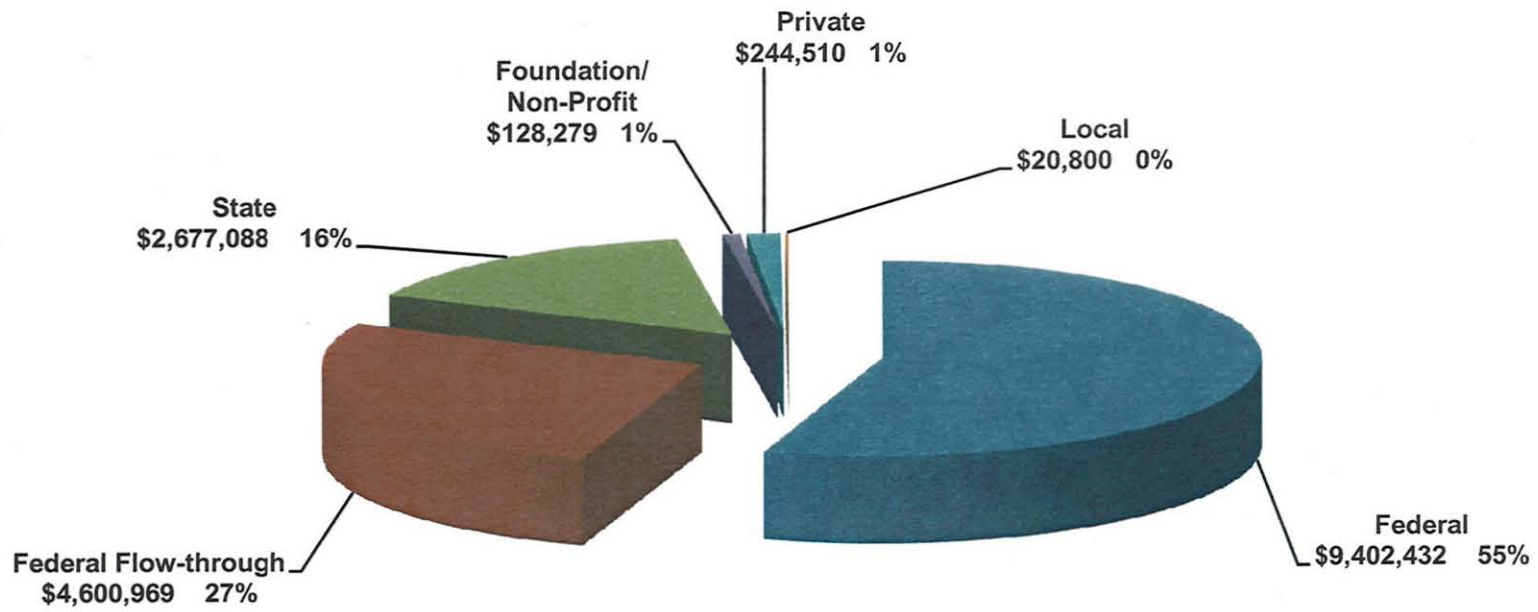
**SUMMARY OF PROPOSALS SUBMITTED

July 1, 2007 through June 30, 2008**



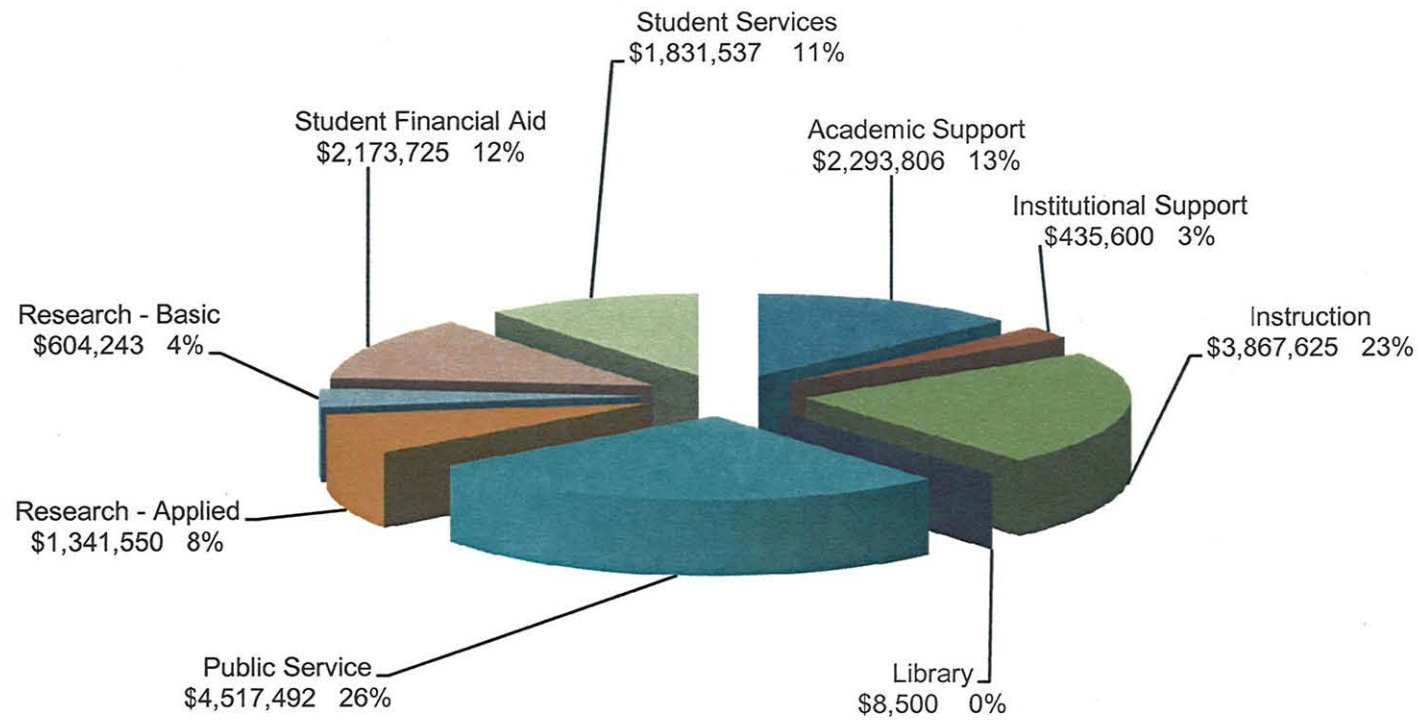
**SUMMARY OF PROPOSALS FUNDED
