#### Foreword

I am pleased to present this annual report of sponsored programs at Morehead State University for the 2008 – 2009 fiscal year. Compiled by Ms. Janet Cline in the Office of Research and Sponsored Programs, this report provides both an overview as well as detailed information of the external funding received by MSU in support of our many on- and off-campus programs.

As may be seen in this report, the number of grant proposals submitted by MSU faculty and staff increased by 9.7% (202 vs 184) compared to the previous fiscal year. Although our overall success rate fell slightly, both the number of proposals funded, and the total amount awarded (\$17.26 million) increased (see page II-1 for a 10 year comparison). The decrease in success rate was expected as faculty have been encouraged to pursue highly prestigious and competitive national grants which generally have very low funding rates (e.g., 15-25%).

Consistent with previous years, 83% of the funding was obtained either directly or indirectly from federal funding sources with the largest amount from the U.S. Department of Education (over \$9.5 million). Of the remaining dollars awarded, 12% was received from the State of Kentucky, with the remaining 5% coming from foundations and other private sources. As expected, most of the funding received will directly or indirectly benefit students. Indeed, funding for instruction, academic services, student services, and student financial aid accounted for almost 60% of total funding. Awards for public service projects and research (applied and basic) accounted for roughly 37%. Most federal research funding was received through the National Institutes of Health and the National Science Foundation (see Page IV-1).

Although the growth in funding for the year (1.1%) failed to meet our target goal of 3-5% per year, given the existing financial conditions of the state and nation, we are pleased that our total funding did not decrease. Fortunately, increases in funding from federal and others sources more than compensated for a 3% decrease in state funding.

Once again, it is important to recognize that these awards are solely due to the efforts of the dedicated faculty and staff listed in this report. We applaud their efforts and congratulate them for their success in securing the external resources necessary for MSU to provide the highest quality educational, research, and public service programs for our constituents.






