## What is SGA?

SGA is the Student Government Association of Morehead State University. This organization exists to serve MSU students by providing an outlet to voice concerns to the administration and allows students an opportunity to become involved on campus.

## Representative Qualifications

## What makes up SGA?

SGA is comprised of three separate interrelated bodies: the Executive Branch, the Legislative Branch, and the Judicial Branch.

The Executive Branch consists of six elected officials who serve on the executive committee. Elections for each position are held every spring.

The Legislative Branch, Student Congress, includes 48 representatives who are chosen from each class and various organizations throughout the University. Elections for Student Congress are held each fall.

The Judicial Branch serves as the Student Court. Its members are appointed by the President and approved by the Student Congress.
