Sports Briefs: The men's basketball team dropped their second straight last weekend, 85-82, at Ball State. Coach Jack Schalow's team returns to action Saturday night at Louisiana Tech and Monday night at Virginia Tech. WMKY air time Saturday will be at 8:10, and at Virginia Tech on Monday at 7:10. The next home game is Dec. 20 against California.

The women's basketball team won one and lost two in their first week of action. Coach Mickey Wells' team lost to Marshall and Western Kentucky and defeated Kentucky State. They return to action January 10 against Kentucky State.

The wrestling team defeated VMI, 37-12, to even its mark 1-1 last weekend. They entertain West Virginia, Northern Kentucky, and Anderson College Saturday at noon at Wetherby Gymnasium.

The swimming team dropped a 70-39 decision to Marshall and finished fourth in the Morris Harvey relays last weekend. They host Berea College today (Tuesday) at 6 p.m.
