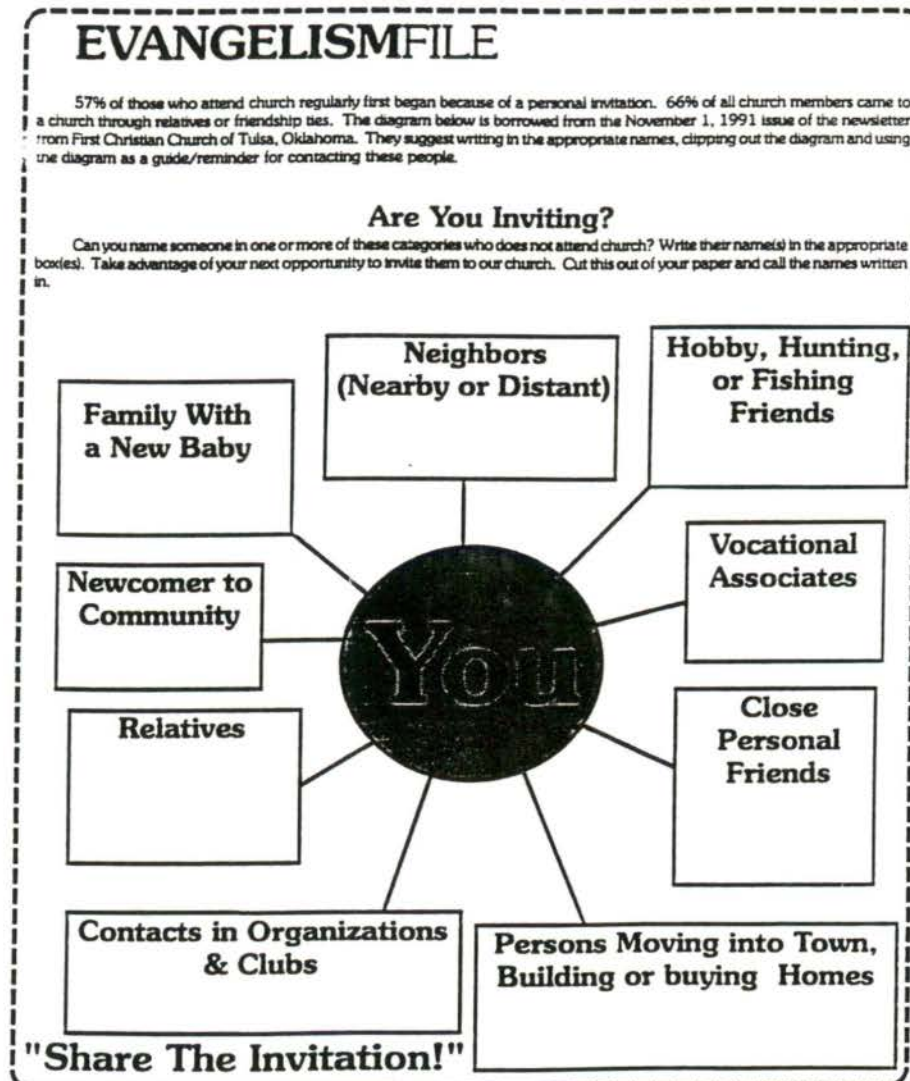

## THE PASTOR'S PEN.....

It's that time of year again when the northern hemisphere of earth tilts towards the sun. The promise of spring is marked by the crocus blooming in the snow and by the appearance of a Robin here and there. The nights grow shorter and the days lengthen and the church enters the season of Lent.....the season of preparation for the Easter Event.

This year, I will be directing my preaching towards the theme of discipline. My preaching schedule will follow the Lectionary Readings for the season and I want to share them with you and ask that you prepare for the Lenten Worship Services by reading the Lectionary Scriptures before we gather for Worship each week.

March 8... First Sunday of Lent, read Psalms 91:9-16; Deuteronomy 26:1-11; Romans 1:8b-13; and Luke 4:1-13.  
Sermon Subject will be, "The Importance of Discipline."

March 15...Second Sunday of Lent, Read Psalms 127: Genesis 15:1-12, 17-18, Philippians 3:17-4:1; and Luke 13:31-35.

March 22...Third Sunday of Lent, Read Psalms 103:1-13; Exodus 3:1-15; I Corinthians 10:1-13; and Luke 13:1-9.  
The Sermon Subject will be: "The Nature of Discipline!"

March 29...Fourth Sunday of Lent, Read Psalms 34:1-8; Joshua 5:9-12; II Corinthians 5:16-20; and Luke 15:1-3, 11-32.  
The Sermon Subject will be, "The Discipline of Repentance"

April 5....Fifth Sunday of Lent, Read Psalms 126: Isaiah 43:16-21, Philippians 3:8-14; and John 12:1-8.  
The Sermon Subject will be, "The Discipline of Love!"

April 12...Sixth Sunday of Lent (Palm Sunday) Read Psalms 118:19-29; Isaiah 50:4-9a; Philippians 2:5-11; and Luke 19:28-40.  
The Sermon Subject will be, "Behold Your King!"

May we discipline our lives by the example of our Lord in this season of Lent and may we increase in faith as we experience the life of Jesus who would redeem us from sin. Let Lent be the season of a spiritual rebirth in all of us.

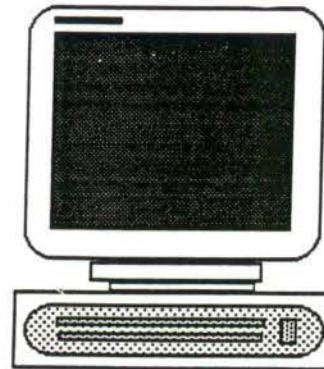

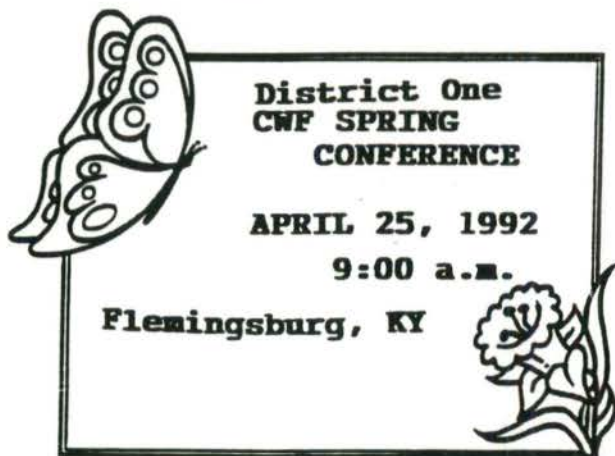

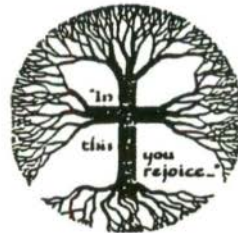

## **NOTES FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK.....**

This has been a good year for forsythia. I trimmed three bushes in my yard in the early spring....trying to round them ....and I did a pretty good job. In less than two months, they are completely out of shape. The top branches reach daily towards the sky and all these bushes appear to be ragged...far from the manicured look I had intended. I need to give them more care.

The Church is like that. It needs goals and attention to it's goals. As we look to a new program year in September, I want us to look to growth. I would challenge you with growth in membership...we need to have a 5% to 10% growth in membership. That means that we need to exceed our losses by death and moving from the community by at least 5% to 10% and to achieve this goal we will need to bring into our fellowship 20 to 40 new people...between July 1, 1992 and June 30, 1993. That's part of the pastor's job, but it's also your job to, as members of the Church.

I'd like to see Worship attendance and Church School attendance increase in the same way. On a given Sunday, only 25% of our membership attends Church School and only 50% of our membership attends worship. You can cause growth by becoming a part of the Church School and Church

Worship of your church. Nothing produces enthusiasm like a crowd and you are the key to such enthusiasm.

We are doing well in our Stewardship...but that too needs to be increased 5% to 10% also. When it's time to plan a new budget, we need to keep these % increases in mind as we plan our personal Stewardship of Christ's Kingdom. YOU are most important.....YOU make the Church Grow....

Like my forsythia, your Church needs regular care. I challenge you to give your Church the care it needs.

#### FOOD PANTRY.....

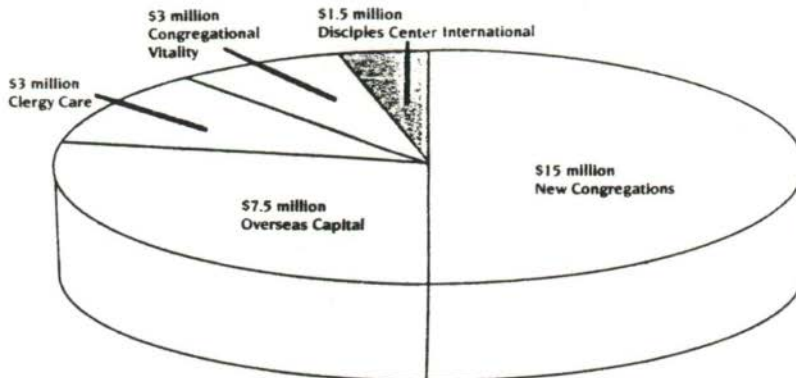
