Biographical / Historical Information: Maxey Flats Nuclear Disposal Site is a radioactive waste dump site in Fleming County, Kentucky. The site received 4.8 million cubic feet of radioactive waste from 1963-1977. The waste was buried in shallow graves that have resulted in contaminated ground water, surface water, and the surrounding soil.

Scope and Content: Collection consists of records, reports, and data pertaining to the Maxey Flats Nuclear Disposal Site located Fleming County, Kentucky. The bulk of the collection contains information about water analysis including tritium activity and HTO content. Records cover federal and state government surveys, records, statistics, maps, etc.
