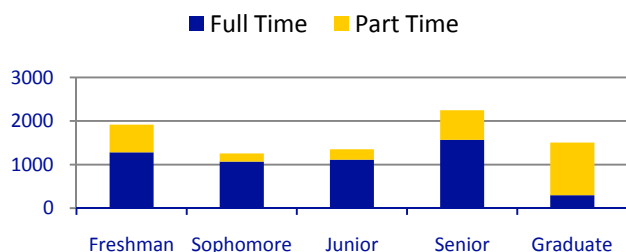

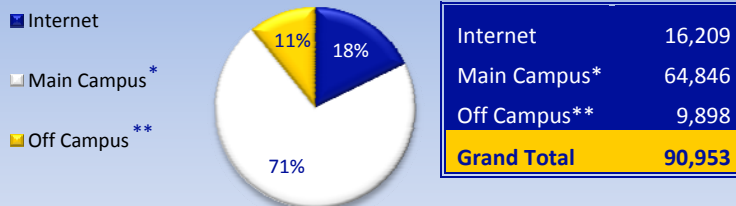
Quick Facts...
