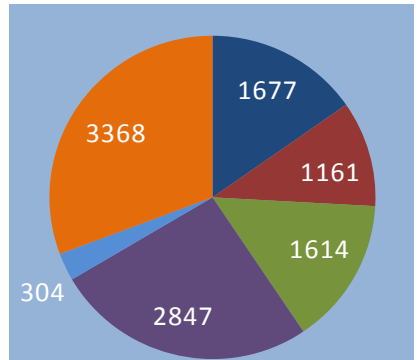

Enrollment Quick Facts

- 541 new transfer students (including 23 Black, Non-Hispanics). 355 transferred from KCTCS.
- 6,882 enrolled from the 22-county service region.
- 2,700 enrolled from other Kentucky counties.
- 1,318 enrolled from 46 other states.
- 71 enrolled from 30 foreign countries.
- 65 Black, Non-Hispanics were among the 1,372 first-time freshmen.
- 73% First-Time Freshman retention rate from Fall 2010 to Fall 2011 (66% for under-represented minorities).
- 2,589 students in MSU residence halls and apartments.
