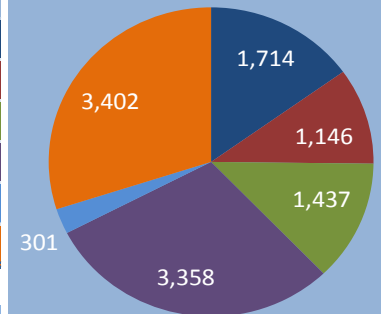

Enrollment Quick Facts

- 501 new transfer students (including 17 Black, Non-Hispanics). 346 transferred from KCTCS.
- 6,601 enrolled from the 22-county service region.
- 3,429 enrolled from other Kentucky counties.
- 1,198 enrolled from 44 other states.
- 130 enrolled from 29 foreign countries.
- 83 Black, Non-Hispanics were among the 1,685 first-time freshmen.
- 68% First-Time Freshman retention rate from Fall 2012 to Fall 2013 (64% for under-represented minorities).
- 3,105 students in MSU residence halls and apartments.
