

### ANOTHER BRICK YARD FOR CARTER COUNTY

Company of Ashland and Big Sandy Men Contemplate Erection of Large Plant Near Upper Tygart

### JOHN C. C. MAYO INTERESTED

That Carter county is to have another brickyard, and that in the near future, is the information we have gotten through a very reliable source. We have been told that a company of Ashland and Big Sandy capitalists—including John C. C. Mayo—have control of about two or three thousand acres of some of the best fire clay land in the country in the vicinity of Upper Tygart and are contemplating the erection of a modern fire brick plant within a comparatively short time.

It is rumored that they have been surveying and drilling on the land and that work will start soon.

A prominent business man made the statement the other day that the gentlemen who control the holdings recently refused an offer of sixty-five thousand dollars and told they would be purchasers that two hundred and fifty thousand dollar would not buy it. The gentleman from whom we got our information says that the property is worth at least four hundred thousand dollars and that it is by far the most valuable tract of clay land in the vicinity.
