**Scope and Content:** Content includes correspondence between Clyde and Robert Young concerning business matters, bank deposit slips, tax receipts for state, county, and property tax belonging to Robert Young dated between 1901 and 1934, 6 pocket day books, business cards, and account statement sheets of the company.
