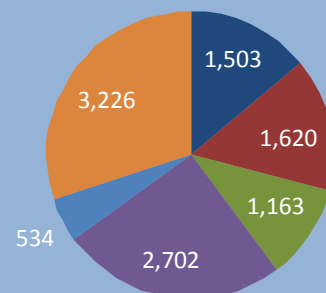

Enrollment Quick Facts

- 453 new transfer students (including 16 Black, Non-Hispanics). 289 transferred from KCTCS.
- 5,685 enrolled from the 22-county service region.
- 3,865 enrolled from other Kentucky counties.
- 991 enrolled from 45 other states.
- 207 enrolled from 27 foreign countries.
- 51 Black, Non-Hispanics were among the 1,273 first-time freshmen.
- 70% First-Time Freshman retention rate from Fall 2015 to Fall 2016 (66% for under-represented minorities).
- 2,843 students in MSU residence halls and apartments.
