Scope and Content: Collection consists of primarily of family photographs, contracts, deeds, receipts and miscellaneous ephemera related to the Caudill family of Morehead, Kentucky from 1870 to 1920. Included with the collection are a few family photographs from the 1950s to 1990s along with a building plan for a mining camp store at Brinegar, Kentucky from 1927.
