Well Mr Sandolt was right. They are sending us to school again for what I don't know. I guess we'll start going in about a week I hope. We're just hanging around now and I like to be on the move all the time.

Mrs Sandolt I hope I didn't have to leave Morehead as soon as I did because I had a nice story prepared to talk about to the young people. I'm sure they would have enjoyed it but you know how the navy

is rust all the time.

Ever since I joined the navy I tried to find a sailor who believed and trusted in God as I do but in my six months in the navy I have never run across one yet. If there are any people who need the Lord it's the men and women in the armed forces because they are going to war and don't realize the danger but the way it is the men and women in the armed forces think very little of Christ and of Eternal life and of the fine things of life. They just think of a good time today and forget about tomorrow.
