Richard Tilford Boyle was born in 1818, in what was then a portion of Mercer, but is now Boyle county.

He was the son of the late Chief Justice John Boyle. He graduated at Princeton College, New Jersey, and at the Transylvania Law School, Lexington.

In 1842 he married the eldest daughter of Hon. Isaac H. Anderson, and grandchild of the late Governor Owsley. He was admitted to the Kentucky bar in 1846, and from 1841 till the breaking out of the war he followed the profession of the law at Danville, Kentucky.

Although he had never before engaged in politics, at the opening of the war he espoused the Federal cause, and was one of the first in Kentucky to publicly advocate the policy of covering the second States. In 1861 he was commissioned a Brigadier General in the United States Army, and raised a brigade in the vicinity of his home.

His command was in the line of the 2nd Kentucky Infantry, and in February, 1862, he joined the 1st Kentucky, and participated in the battle of Shiloh. In the month of July following he was placed in command of the 1st Kentucky, and soon after was placed over the newly-created district of Western Kentucky, in the department of Ohio, under General W. H. Worth.
