CERTIFICATES

The College Elementary certificate issued prior to September 1, 1932, cannot be renewed. The law providing for that certificate was repealed at the 1932 session of the Kentucky Legislature, giving place to the law providing for the new College Elementary certificate issued on 32 hours of prescribed and elective college work earned in residence. All of the college work which has been done in residence will count on the new certificate—regardless of whether a previous certificate has been issued on it or not.
