September 1, 1935.)**

**1. ELEMENTARY CERTIFICATES**

- A. Provisional Elementary, valid for three years, issued on the basis of 64 semester hours (curriculum for training of elementary teachers).
- B. Standard Elementary, valid for four years, issued on the basis of graduation from a standard four-year college (curriculum for training of elementary teachers).

**2. HIGH SCHOOL CERTIFICATES**

- A. Provisional High School, valid for four years, issued on the basis of graduation from a standard four-year college (curriculum for training of high school teachers).
- B. Standard High School, valid for five years, issued to college graduates with one year of graduate work (curriculum for training of high school teachers).

**3. CERTIFICATES IN ADMINISTRATION AND SUPERVISION**

- A. Provisional, valid for four years, issued to persons with two years' successful teaching experience, and being a graduate of a standard four-year college (curriculum for training of administrators and supervisors).
- B. Standard, valid for five years, issued on two years' experience, four years of college work, and one year of graduate study.
