## SCHOOL BOOK COMMISSION

GOV. McCREARY DELIBERATE IN MAKING SELECTION OF MEMBERS TEXT BOOK BOARD.

### WILL LET \$5,000,000 AWARD

To Supply Text Books for the Common Schools of Kentucky for the ensuing five years—Twelve Men to Constitute Board.

(Special Frankfort Correspondence.) Frankfort, Ky.—Gov. McCreary is taking his time about the appointment of the commission which is to let the \$5,000,000 contract to supply text books for the common schools of Kentucky for the ensuing five years. The present contract with the American Book Co. will expire next July, and the governor is considering a list of eligible men for appointment to the commission. One of the serious problems connected with the selection of men is to keep off the commission any one who might be prejudiced in favor of any bidder. The commission will be composed of the governor, state superintendent of public instruction, Barkshire, J. W. Herring, William G. Stevens, J. W. Herring, William Phillips, John P. Haswell, Jr., Edwin C. Morgan, W. L. Hazell, George A. Long, of Louisville, and O. H. Skiles, of Frankfort.

### Insurance Company Incorporated.

The Metropolitan Fire Insurance company of Richmond, Jefferson county, with a capital stock of \$250,000, will be one of the first Kentucky insurance companies organized to solve the insurance problem in this state. Its articles of incorporation were filed with Secretary of State Crecelius. The stock is divided into 25,000 shares, and \$25,000 must be paid in before the company can do business. The incorporators are H. O. Williams, J. L. Richardson, G. H. Russell, John M. Davis, Smith T. Bailey, G. E. Stevens, J. W. Herring, William Phillips, John P. Haswell, Jr., Edwin C. Morgan, W. L. Hazell, George A. Long, of Louisville, and O. H. Skiles, of Frankfort.

### Butler Makes Demand For Salary.

J. F. Butler, of Pike county, has demanded his salary for March as Judge of the Thirty-fifth district. The commission was awarded him, but in a recent case (asked by his Democratic opponent, J. M. Robertson, the circuit court and court of appeals held the election invalid. Butler's salary allowance pending the appeal. The auditor has not decided whether he will pay his salary of \$350 for March. It is understood he claims the pay as de facto judge.

### Bids Were Very Close.

Bids for supplying fuel for the state prisons, about \$50,000 contract were so close that the state board of prison commissioners decided to have a test of the coal made for heat units. The Cabin Creek, Carbon Fuel, Kentucky Gem, Davy's Run and Clear Creek Coal companies will all enter the contest. The bids ranged from \$2.02 to \$2.05 the ton.

### County Assessments Fixed.

The state board of equalization increased the assessment of Harlan county five per cent on lands. The assessment of Knott and Knox counties will remain the same as last year. The board fixed the tentative assessment of Jefferson county at \$294,950, \$20, the same as last year.

### Capt. Breckenridge Again on Duty.

Capt. E. L. Breckenridge, U. S. A., who underwent an operation in the winter and has been on sick leave for several months, has returned from Fort Bayard, N. M., and has resumed his duties as sector of the Kentucky National.

### Assessment Values Raised.

The state board of equalization made the following increased assessments: Bell county, 10 per cent on lands, and 12 per cent on town lots; Boyd county, 10 per cent on lands and town lots.

## CARTER FAIR, AUG. 26 to 29

The stockholders of the Grayson Amusement Company held their annual election on Monday, April 6th, for the purpose of electing officers and directors to conduct the Carter County Fair this year. The following were elected: Dr. J. W. Stovall, President; Ex-Senator W. B. Whitt, Vice-President; G. W. E. Wolford, Secretary; W. T. Womack, Treasurer; and the following directors, viz: Dr. J. W. Stovall, G. W. E. Wolford, W. T. Womack, J. D. Littlejohn and E. A. Phipps. An Advisory Board, consisting of J. F. Lewis, C. S. Hitchens, A. A. James, W. H. Castner, C. E. Landers and I. D. Stamper, was also elected, and the date for the Carter County Fair fixed for the 26th to 29th of August.

Work will be commenced at once to put the race track and fair ground in condition and the company will spare neither time nor money to have everything in shape for the Fair.

The Grayson Amusement Co. is composed of a lot of our best business and professional men, and a number of progressive farmers who realize what a good County Fair is worth to the county, and they intend to make the 1914 meeting an improvement over anything in the past.

### Atlas At Work

The machinery at the Atlas Stone Co.'s crusher was started going Monday morning after an idleness of several months. The first of the coming month this concern expects to install a pulverizer; the machine now being held on board cars in Ashland, awaiting completion of installation. This machine has a capacity of 100 tons per day, which product is used as fertilizer to supply limestone soil. With the addition of this machine the plant is expected to run 365 days a year; in other words, run regular, bar accidents.

### Eastern Kentucky Has New Service.

Representative John W. Langley, of Pikeville, Ky., announced that the postoffice department has decided to establish mail service on the Big Sandy and Kentucky railroad between Dawkins and Riceville. The service will start April 27th.

No purses will be given for less than \$400 up \$600. There are always about 500 horses quartered at the track and it is expected that there will be about 200 more for the Charleston special bearing the following males arrived with J. S. Ward, W. T. Woodward, Jr., W. J. Spears, J. J. McCaffery, J. W. Johnson, E. L. Moore, E. L. Pearson and Dave Vitto, and 33 wards stable includes Ancon, the most remarkable horse at the Charleston track this winter.

### Hardin Teachers' Institute.

The Hardin County Teachers' Institute will convene in this city July 8 and will be in session five days. Prof J. C. Noy, of the State University, at Lexington, will be the instructor, and School Superintendent J. A. Payne will be the conductor. Many eminent educators of the state will probably address the institute. There are thirty-five graded and one hundred rural teachers in the county who will be in attendance for a certainty, while a large number of visiting teachers will probably enroll. One hundred and fifty teachers all told are expected to be in attendance. Prof. Noy is recognized as one of the best and foremost instructors in the state and an excellent institute is anticipated.

### Hitch in Get-Together Plan.

The definite and final refusal of the insurance companies to consider the compromise proposition offered by Rufus Luffon, chairman of the state insurance rating board is the most important development in the insurance situation. Next in importance was the fact that Gov. McCreary, Auditor Bagworth and Attorney-General Garnett have sent out invitations to the insurance companies to send their executive officers to Louisville for a conference April 18. Many express hope that an adjustment will be reached at that time. These two developments and the renewal of the discussion in regard to the constitutionality of the Green law are the new angles to the situation.

### Puson Farm Lease Is Approved.

At a meeting of the sinking fund commission the lease of 460 acres on the Glenn's Creek road from Mrs. Gilbert Mastin to be used as a prison farm in connection with the Frankfort Reformatory was approved. The lease is for two years at \$2,000 a year, with an option to purchase the land for \$80 the acre.

The Nicholas County Fair association is to be incorporated here at once with a capital stock of \$10,000, with H. N. Rankin, W. H. Fry, E. E. Darrell, John M. Donnell, B. T. Henry, Charles W. G. P. Ledford, of Upper Blue Lick Springs; J. M. Berry, of Moorefield, and William D. McIntire, of Millersburg, as incorporators.

### New Job For W. O. Head.

Louisville, Ky.—Former Mayor W. O. Head has been elected president of the Louisville Water company at a salary of \$5,000. He succeeds Charles E. Grainger, who for the last four years has been at the head of the municipally-owned plant.

**BLANK PAGES IN BOOK OF LIVES.**

By Pastor Ernest A. Tappert.

Text: "Therefore to him that knoweth to do good, and doeth it not, to him it is sin."—James, iv, 17.

St. James speaks of the blank pages in the book of our lives. They teach a lesson which is often overlooked. Whenever we go over our book of life we are mostly attracted by the pages written in gold that tell of our good works. Of these pages there are but few, and in most cases the "gold" is only brass. Most of the pages are full of spots and stains, and written on them are the works of darkness. There is scarcely a day on which new pages of this kind are not added.

It is in between these are pages with nothing written on them, and most people look at them without any disturbance of conscience. They even regard these with a certain quietude of mind, saying, "Thank God, there is a day on which I have done no evil!" Is that true? St. James, in our text, says "No." And then he opens our eyes to the meaning of the blank pages in the book of our lives, saying, "Therefore to him that knoweth to do good, and doeth it not, to him it is sin."

Here we must look back and note the many shortcomings and neglects of our lives. ## HOW TO COOK ON THE CASSEROLE

(By a Reader.)

Perhaps my experience with casserole cooking may be valuable to unbelievers. I was rather skeptical as to its facts, but after several trials find myself the staunchest of advocates.

Casserole Beef.  
I had on hand the end of a porterhouse steak, probably three-quarters of a pound, a turnip, a carrot, an onion, two potatoes which needed attention and a cup of tomato, mostly juice. Having cut the steak in pieces about an inch square and seared it on all sides, I removed the meat and added more fat to the pan, turned in the sliced onion and carrot, also the sliced potato and turnip, and let them brown a little. Having heated the casseroles, I turned in half of the mixed vegetables. On these I arranged the meat and then added the remaining vegetables. Over all I poured the tomato juice, to which had been added a cup of boiling water, salt, pepper and kitchen bouquet for seasoning. The casserole went into a well-baked oven at four o'clock, and a quarter of an hour later I turned the heat down as low as possible (using but one burner), left the kitchen and did not enter it again until a quarter of six, when to the gravy I added a little thickening of flour and butter beaten to a cream and set the casserole back to keep hot while I prepared the remainder of my dinner. As our main dish was such a heavy one, we had with it only an apple salad, and for dessert a white jelly made the previous day.

We found our casserole a most useful institution. The meat was tender and delicious, the vegetables done to a turn and the gravy rich and brown with a nicely blended flavor. This quantity was far too much for a family of two, and my husband asked to have the same kind of a dinner the following day because it was so good. So I added a little water, a little thickening and just heated the whole. We had spinach with it and a baked custard for dessert.

Two such simple dinners for the busy housewife and such inexpensive ones, too! The steak, which cost fifty cents, supplied meat for three dinners, and the vegetables for the casserole certainly cost less than five cents. Best of all, it was good, and so easy to prepare. There is hardly any limit to the number of changes which may be made in a combination. I often add a spoonful or two of oysters, sometimes a little celery, and sometimes the celery itself. A friend always includes string beans. Try it for yourselves, all you unbelievers.

Pretty Nightgown At  
But Little Expense

It seems to be a prevalent idea that pretty nightgowns are too much trouble to make since they may be bought so cheaply in the stores. But there is one pattern which is so simple that it pays to make it and the finest material may be used as there is practically no expenditure for extra laces and embroideries.

This is cut in two pieces, the front including half of the sleeves, which are cut in one with the gown and the back including the other half of the sleeves.

The fullness at the top may be put into fine tucks or gathered into a simple heading. If the half length bell sleeves are cut short to form shoulder straps this model could readily be transformed into a combination petticoat and corset cover.

## NEW IDEAS FOR HATPINS.

Hand Embroidered Ones, Simple to Work, Quite the Rage.

A novel style of hatpin which is coming quite the rage is hand embroidered. These hatpins are very simple to work, and can be embroidered in colors harmonizing with the hat in which they are worn, and can be further ornamented with beads or imitation jewels.

Take a piece of material, either linen, canvas or perhaps velvet, and trace but the requisite number of circles. Be careful to leave sufficient space between them to allow for turning back the material over the mount for the pin. In each circle a design should be traced or stamped, as elaborate or as crude as you like. It is better not to cut out the circles until they are embroidered, for which purpose the material can be stretched and worked on a frame such as is used for drawn thread work, as this insures the circles keep their shape.

For a set of hatpins and buttons for a blouse half a yard of material should be sufficient. Buttons and hatpins to match are quite a new feature and have until now been seen only in expensive embroidery. When the embroidery is finished, cover a plain disk of button mould with it and turn the material and stitch it neatly at the back. Then, with another plain piece of material, cover this fastening on and stitch it neatly all round the edge. Sometimes, a close, buttonhole edge looks very pretty worked in the same color as the rest of the embroidery.

The large hatpins, which have had such vogue for some time past and have worn shabby, can be used up in this way, when it is quite an easy matter to cover them with a piece of plain material and embroider them. If, however, the ordinary size pins are used, the pin should be slipped through the hole at the top before the material is fixed, and a few drops of sealing wax will be sufficient to keep it firmly in position, says Home Notes.



# Kentucky Debt

Washington, D. C. March, '14.—Preliminary figures from the forthcoming bulletin pertaining to national and state indebtedness and funds and investments have been given out by the Director of the Bureau of the Census, Department of Congress. The bulletin carries information for the state of Kentucky as well as for the other states and the United States.

An inspection of the tables for Kentucky in the bulletin soon to be issued shows a fluctuating bonded indebtedness, varying in amounts from \$680,000 in 1891 to \$1,007,000 in 1898. The special debt obligations to public trust funds increased to \$2,313,000 in 1898. The floating debt changed with each year, though reporting a general increase of \$1,790,000 from 1891 to 1913.

Although the population of the state increased steadily during the period of 30 years, the ratio of increase was not sufficient to offset the marked increase in the debt less sinking fund assets, hence the debt per capita advanced nearly 200 per cent. from 1880 to 1913.

In 1880 the total debt of Kentucky at the close of the fiscal year, June 30, was \$1,863,000; in 1891 it was \$2,562,000; in 1913 it had advanced to \$4,452,000. The population of the state increased from 1,649,000 in 1880 to 2,336,000 in 1913; the average increase of 21,000 was not sufficient to appreciably affect the average increase of \$101,000 in the total debt less sinking fund assets, hence the continued increase in the per cent. per capita. In 1880 the debt per capita was 66c.; in 1891 it was 98c.; in 1913 it had risen to \$1.90, this being the largest amount recorded for any year during the period discussed.

At the present time about 2.4 per cent. of the total population of the United States will be

found in the state of Kentucky, and 1.3 per cent. of the total debt (less sinking fund assets) is attributed to that state.
