

Tolliver's Slayers Acquitted.

MOREHEAD, Ky., Sept. 2.—Hiram Pigman and Ap Perry, indicted for the murder of Craig Tolliver, were acquitted by the jury. Four attorneys, led by Taylor Young, represented the commonwealth, and Wallace McGuire, J. G. Cassidy, of Fleming county, J. F. Hazelrigg, and Boone Logan defended the prisoners. The verdict was no surprise, and meets the approval of the public. John Trumb, indicted for shooting Howard Logan, gave himself up, and is now in jail. He and Morse Little, charged with the murder of a man named Morrow, will be tried this week.
