COMMITTS SUICIDE

Undoubtedly the most shocking news that has been brought to the ears of the people of this neighborhood and for a distance round, was that of the death of William H. Counts, which occurred on the night of Tuesday July 4th.

He had, most of the day, been on the streets of town together with his wife and other friends and never before seemed to be more satisfied with life, more jolly nor in every way seemed to have had life pass more to his own pleasure than the day preceding the night of his death, and this fact was very noticeable and spoken of by many of those with whom he talked that day.

At about eleven o'clock that night the report of a revolver awoke his wife who was sleeping by his side only for her to witness the awful scene of her husband lying lifeless beside her, the ball entering the temple, killing him instantly.

On the following morning an inquest was held and the jury handed a decision of death by suicide, upon the evidence submitted.

For several years he had been employed by Vansant, Kitchen & Co., at Ashland, and we understand had resigned his position with them and told of his intentions of possibly entering business here for himself.

His remains were lain to rest in the Brook's home cemetery on Thursday the 6th, under the auspices of the Masonic order.

Killed by a Train.

Rufus Garvin, known by most as one of the "twin brothers," was struck by a freight on the night of July 4th, and killed.

He came into town that night on passenger 24 and had got as far as Limestone on his way home and had sat down on the end of the ties supposedly to rest and being as we understand heavily under the influence of intoxicants, is supposed to have fell asleep and was not aware of the advent of the train.

He was knocked a considerable distance from the track but was not mangled, living a short time and was conscious to within three minutes to his death and to tell that the train had struck him. A tramp riding the pilot of the engine, when the train came into town, told some of the crew that they had struck a man a distance up the track.

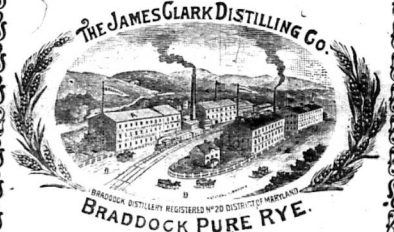
