**Biographical / Historical Information:** Francis Louis Bailey attended Morehead State University from 1969 to 1973 and worked as a photographer for the student newspaper, the *Trail Blazer*. He graduated with a Bachelor of Arts degree in Radio & Television on August 2, 1973. He currently is a practicing chiropractic in Lexington, Kentucky.

**Scope and Content:** Collection consists of photographic negatives believed to have been taken by Louis Bailey in the early 1970s. The images in the collection are of people and places unique to eastern and central Kentucky, including the *Mister Hanes* Ferry Boat, Shiloh Methodist Church in Rosslyn and Spendthrift Farm in Lexington. Many of the images are not identified.
