Biographical / Historical Information: The Morehead Area Habitat of Humanity was established in Rowan County, Kentucky in January of 1987 and received official status in late 1988. The organization has been in operation since that date but changed its name to Cave Run Habitat for Humanity in 2015. Habitat for Humanity is a nonprofit housing organization that works with local communities to provide low-cost housing for individuals and families in need.

Scope and Content: The collection consists of agendas, meeting minutes, correspondence, budgets, by-laws, agreements, and organizational policies and procedures of the Morehead Area Habitat of Humanity of Rowan County, Kentucky from 1990 to 2012. The collection includes the meeting minutes, supplementary materials, and ephemera of the organizations Fund Raising Committee from 2002 to 2009.
