Mr. James Baileys, a worthy young man about 25 years of age, eldest son of James Baileys, Esq., was drowned last night in the Ohio river, at the lower ferry landing in Abbeville, Mo. He is a native of Missouri, and was employed as a laborer on the boat. He was about 5 feet 10 inches tall, with a fair complexion, dark eyes, and a mustache. He was wearing a blue shirt, dark trousers, and a hat. His body was found about 10 o'clock this morning. He was drowned at the same spot where young Wainman lost his life, the same time, about a year ago. The current there is remarkably swift, and the water deep. It is very dangerous to go swimming at the spot, and the public should be warned against it.
