Biographical / Historical Information: Arthur Leroy Stewart was born on August 11, 1922, Bluestone, Kentucky. At the beginning of the Second World War, he worked at Patterson Airfield near Dayton, Ohio for the United States Army Air Corps and in 1943 joined the United States Army. He served in Europe with an Engineering battalion attached to the Air Corps. While in Europe he became interested in photography and became a freelance photographer when he returned to Rowan County. After the war, he attended Morehead State College and graduated with a degree in Industrial Technology. In 1960, he took over his father's machine shop and gave up photography. For over thirty years he worked as a machinist and welder in Morehead. Stewart died in Morehead on August 8, 2003, and is buried in the Siloam Cemetery in Bluestone, Kentucky.

Scope and Content: The collection consists of photographic negatives of Morehead State College from the collection of Art Stewart from 1948 to 1959. Many of the negatives were published in either the Morehead State College yearbook or the student newspaper. The negatives include campus activities, such as plays, dances, sporting events, and other social activities. There is a wide array of clubs featured within this collection, namely the Campus Club, Morehead Players, and other social and academic organizations. Included in the collection

are campus building construction sites and several off-campus businesses, such as Goldie's Department Store and the Tackett Service Station.
