Sterling, was wounded in the right knee by an accidental discharge of a revolver. The ball, a 38-calibre, lodged near the bone, where it remained until Monday when Dr. Jones removed it. Its eight years of rubbing against the bone had reduced the ball thirty-three grains in weight.
