

Will Young Sues Newspaper.

Will A. Young, an attorney of Morehead, Ky., Saturday filed suit for \$100,000 damages against the Pulitzer Publishing Company (Post-Dispatch), alleging libel. He complains of an article in the Post-Dispatch March 24, 1907, declaring him in the same class as his clients.

The article went on to say, he alleges, that Young, who was Judge Hargis' attorney, took a leading part in the Tolliver-Martin feud in Kentucky in behalf of his father and that sixteen men were killed and thirty-two wounded as a result of the feud.

Young declares the statements false and says he was subjected to criticism and even danger as a result of the story.
