**SOLDIERS HOMESTEADS.**  
The Act Providing Homesteads for Soldiers as Signed by the President.

WASHINGTON, D. C. April 9.—The following important act, which became a law by signature of the President Thursday last, has not hitherto been published in full.

It is enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled, That every private soldier and other person who has served in the army of the United States during the recent rebellion for ninety days or more, and who was honorably discharged, and has remained loyal to the Government, including the troops mustered into the service of the United States by virtue of the third section of an act entitled "An act making appropriations for completing the detestation of Washington, and for other purposes," approved February 13, 1862; and every army, marine and officer who was honorably discharged, and has remained loyal to the Government, shall, on compliance with the provisions of an act entitled "An act to grant and extend certain benefits to actual settlers on the public domain," and the act supplementary thereto, as hereinafter modified, be entitled to enter upon and receive patents for a quantity of public land (not exceeding 160 acres, or one quarter section, to be taken in compact form according to legal subdivision, including the alternate reserve sections of public lands along the line of any railroad or other public work, not otherwise reserved or appropriated, and other lands subject to entry under the homestead laws of the United States) provided, that the said homestead settler shall be allowed six months, after locating his homestead, within which to commence his settlement and improvement, and in default of such commencement, the right to the land shall revert to the United States.

That in the case of the death of any person who was entitled to a homestead under the provisions of this act, his widow, if unmarried, or in the case of death by marriage, then his minor orphan children, by a guardian duly appointed and officially accredited as the Department of the Interior, shall be entitled to all the benefits conferred by this act, subject to all the provisions as to settlement and improvements thereon contained in this act, and if such person died during his term of enlistment in the army or navy, his estate shall be deemed to have been disposed of as if he had died during his term of enlistment, and the provisions of this act shall apply to his estate as if he had died during his term of enlistment.
