


At a meeting of the Board of Regents of the Morehead State Teachers College held at the Administration Building, Morehead, Kentucky, at seven o'clock P. M., November 4th, 1935, pursuant to notice, Dr. James H. Richmond, Superintendent of Public Instruction and ex officio chairman, Dr. A. C. Taylor, Dr. J. M. Rose, Judge D. B.
