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## INTRODUCTION

The Bureau of Research and Development of Morehead State University has functioned as a service agent in the Appalachian Region since 1964. The Appalachian Adult Education Center has been an integral part of the Bureau and has collected and published numerous materials in this time span of interest to persons in many areas of specialization. This bibliography is divided into two sections:

- (1) Materials from the Bureau of Research and Development.
- (2) Materials from the Appalachian Adult Education Center.

The Research Library which is located in the Bureau of Research and Development includes research reports and reports from Federally and state-funded projects awarded to Morehead State University between 1964 and 1976. These entries, listed by subjects, include a brief description of each publication along with other pertinent data. All materials herein can be obtained upon request to the Bureau. Materials marked with an asterisk (\*) are available in limited copies but may be obtained until these copies run out.

The Appalachian Adult Education Center section covers a nine-year span of time. Entries include references related to proposal reports, products and articles. This section of the bibliography has been presented under three major divisions:

- I. Appalachian Adult Education Center Grant Awards: 1967-1975. A listing of titles, authority (Grantor) and Grant Period is presented in Table I in this section.
- II. Appalachian Adult Education Center Module Project Sites. Because of the nature of the Appalachian Adult Education Center as a "regional" experimental, developmental, demonstration and research center covering the Appalachian portion of thirteen states, most Appalachian Adult Education Center proposals and final reports are "summaries" of many separate "module reports." Each module project was designed to introduce improved practices demonstrated in other modules and each specifically focused upon one or more of twelve Appalachian Adult Education Center component objectives—identified problem areas in adult basic education in need of improved practice in special demonstration, developmental or research activity.

Table 2 presents a complete listing of all Appalachian Adult Education Center module projects categorized by state. Each of the listings in Table 2 includes a notation of the major component(s) addressed by the module; the name of the module site director; and the county location(s) of the project within the state(s).

All proposals, Table I, and module site projects, Table 2, for each title and for each grant year are documented and represented by numerous documents:

1. A preliminary proposal as might have been required by legislative guidelines.
2. A proposal with annotated negotiations and addendums.
3. A work-agreement with the Appalachian Adult Education Center for funding, monitoring and evaluation purposes developed in community planning for each module project site.
4. Interim reports and special reports as required by grantor guidelines or directives (most often semi-annually or quarterly).
5. Evaluation reports as required by grantor guidelines or directives and often external evaluations and Appalachian Adult Education Center internal evaluations developed in planning proposal development.
6. Final reports as required by the grantor guidelines or directives. (The Appalachian Adult Education Center final reports were most often "summaries" of multiple module projects' final reports.)

III. Appalachian Adult Education Center Final Reports, Products, Publications, and Articles. Of the documents listed above in Section I, items 1-6, in conjunction with Tables 1 and 2, only the final reports, products, publications and articles are reported in the third division of this section of the bibliography.

Appalachian Adult Education Center documents are presented under several different approaches to categorization in the Table of Contents: there are materials which address the general area of adult education, specific Appalachian Adult Education Center component objectives, different geographic areas which are products of one or more studies, non-pring mediated products, or Appalachian Adult Education Center findings presented in journal or magazine articles.

Although many of the documents noted in the Appalachian Adult Education Center section of the bibliography could be termed fugitive with single copies available only through the vestiges of the Appalachian Adult Education Center, most are available through ERIC, the U.S. Office of Education, and the National Multi-media Center for Adult Education.
