Jesse Underwood Killed While Entering His Father's House.

GRAYSON, KY, Oct. 13,-Jesse Uuderwood was shot Friday noon while entering his father's house, and died from the effects of the shot Sunday morning, which leaves George Under wood as the only survivor of that unfortunate family. Notice was given by those opposing

the Underwoods that anybody who would try to bury the remains of Jesse or rescue George, who is quite serious ly wounded, would be killed. CINCINNATI, Oct. 13 .- The Gazette's special report from Grayson, Kv., says

Jessee Underwood, was shot in the door of his father's house, known as Fort Underwood, yesterday morning. The Holbrook party surrounded the house, threatening to kill anybody who would dare to bury Jesse's body or rescue George, who is badly wounded, and with the women and children all that remains of the unfortunate Under wood family are inside of the house. 2 George sent word to the county Judge praying for help and protection. The Governor has been appealed to, but has not responded. This is the fifth murder within the last three weeks in e i men.
